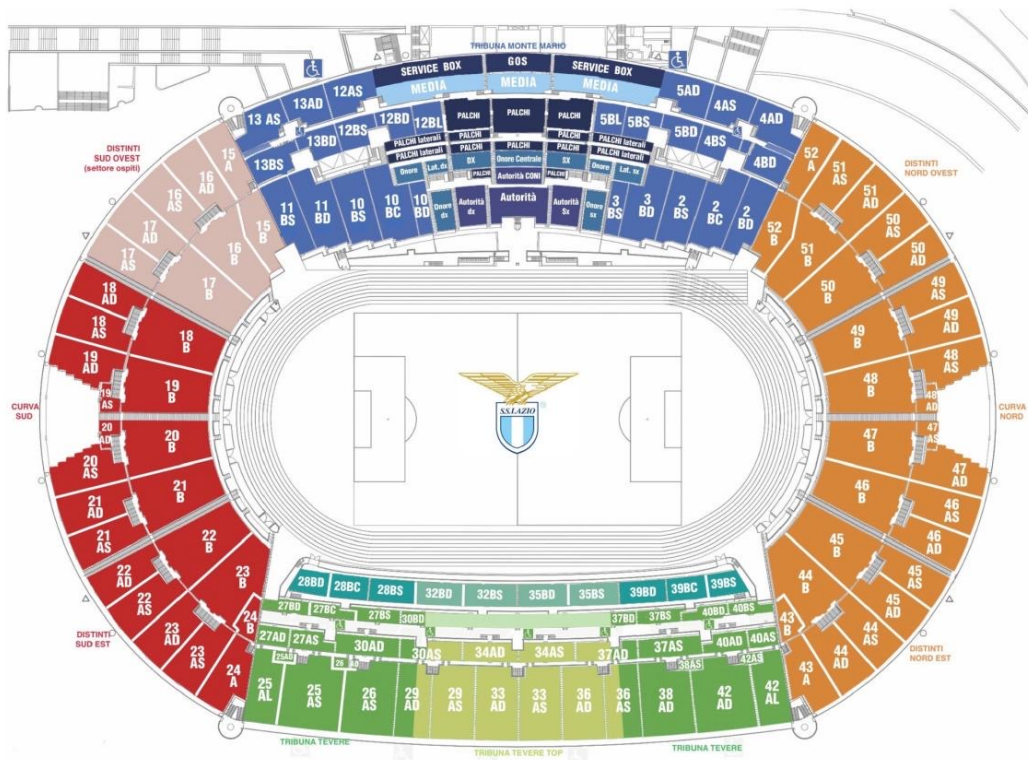

HOW TO GET TO THE STADIUM



AIRPLANE

From Ciampino, take the bus to Termini via Anagnina (Metro Line A – Red Line), which departs near the Arrivals Terminal exit. Then take the Metro with three possible options: Ottaviano, Lepanto, or Flaminio, and afterwards follow the signs to the stadium (Foro Italico).

TRAIN

Arriving at Termini Station (6 km from the Stadio Olimpico in Rome).

Take Metro Line A (Red Line), direction Battistini, and follow the signs to the Stadio Olimpico (Foro Italico).



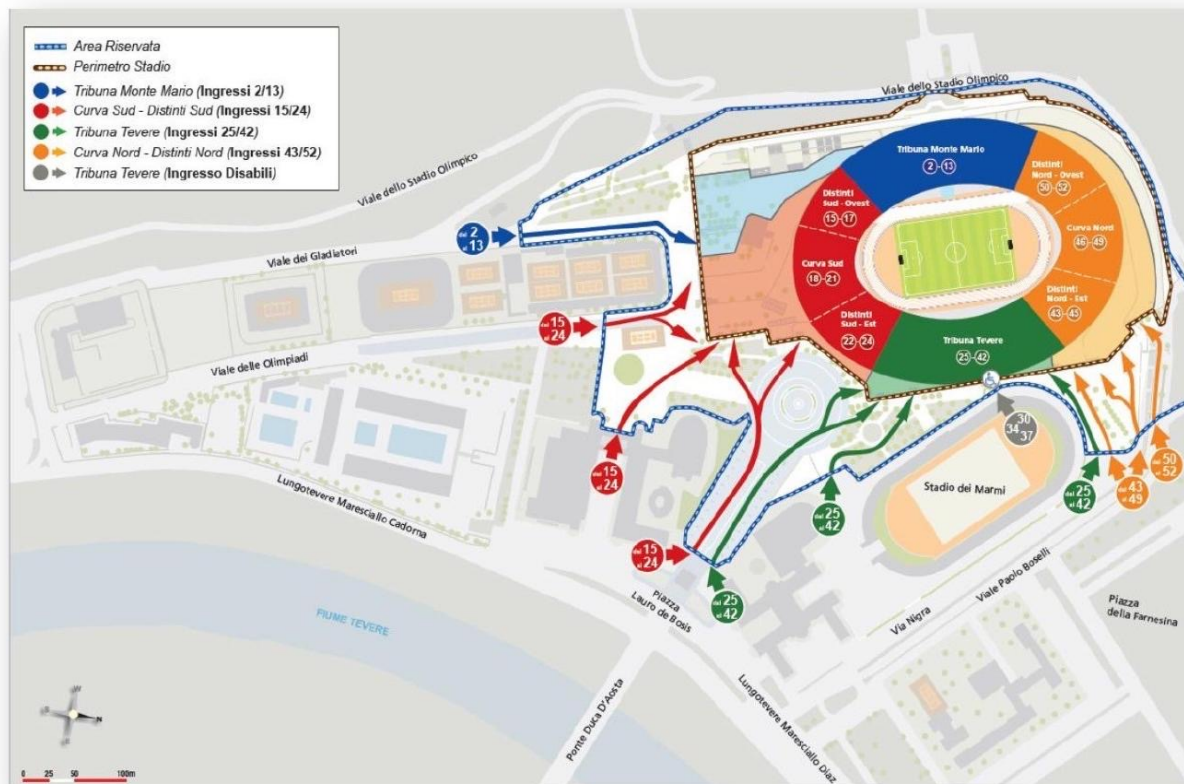
HIGHWAY

Arriving from Milan, Florence, or Bologna (A1 Motorway).

Exit onto the G.R.A. (Ring Road) in the direction of Aurelia, then follow the signs to the stadium (Foro Italico).



PARKING



Parking for the visiting supporters arriving in Rome will be arranged in «Via Lungo Tevere della Vittoria - Piazza maresciallo giardino»

Local authorities will provide all on-site instructions regarding the exact areas to be used.

HOME TEAM



Luigi Bigiarelli was the founder of the “Società Podistica Lazio”, established in Rome on January 9th, 1900 together with his brother Giacomo and seven other friends.

In 1901, football was added among the various disciplines, and in 1904 the first derby of the capital was played won by Lazio 3–0 thanks to a hat-trick from centre-forward Sante Ancherani. On that occasion, Lazio also inaugurated its own kits, white and sky blue, handcrafted by Sante's family. It would take until 1958 to see Lazio win its first trophy, the Coppa Italia, beating Fiorentina in the final. During

the 1958/59 season, Lazio became the first club to display the cockade on the shirt.

On November 18th, 1965, a historic event took place at Lazio: the appointment of Umberto Lenzi as president of the club who, almost a decade later, would lead Lazio to its first league title.

In the 1973/74 season, the team was essentially the same as the one that had enjoyed an exceptional previous year, with the stable addition of D'Amico, a jewel from the youth academy.

It was a Sunday in May precisely May 12th, 1974 when Lazio celebrated the conquest of its first Scudetto.

In 1990, a highly prestigious and widely renowned figure arrived to take charge of Lazio's bench: 1982 World Cup champion Dino Zoff, who was given the task of helping the team make a quality leap. In 1993, Lazio finished fifth, returning to European competitions after 15 years of absence.

In 2000, Lazio achieved the feat of the national treble, winning the Scudetto and the Coppa Italia within five days defeating Juventus in the league and Inter in the cup and on September 8th, in a festive Stadio Olimpico, they beat Inter again in the Italian Super Cup, raising the trophy into the Roman sky.
