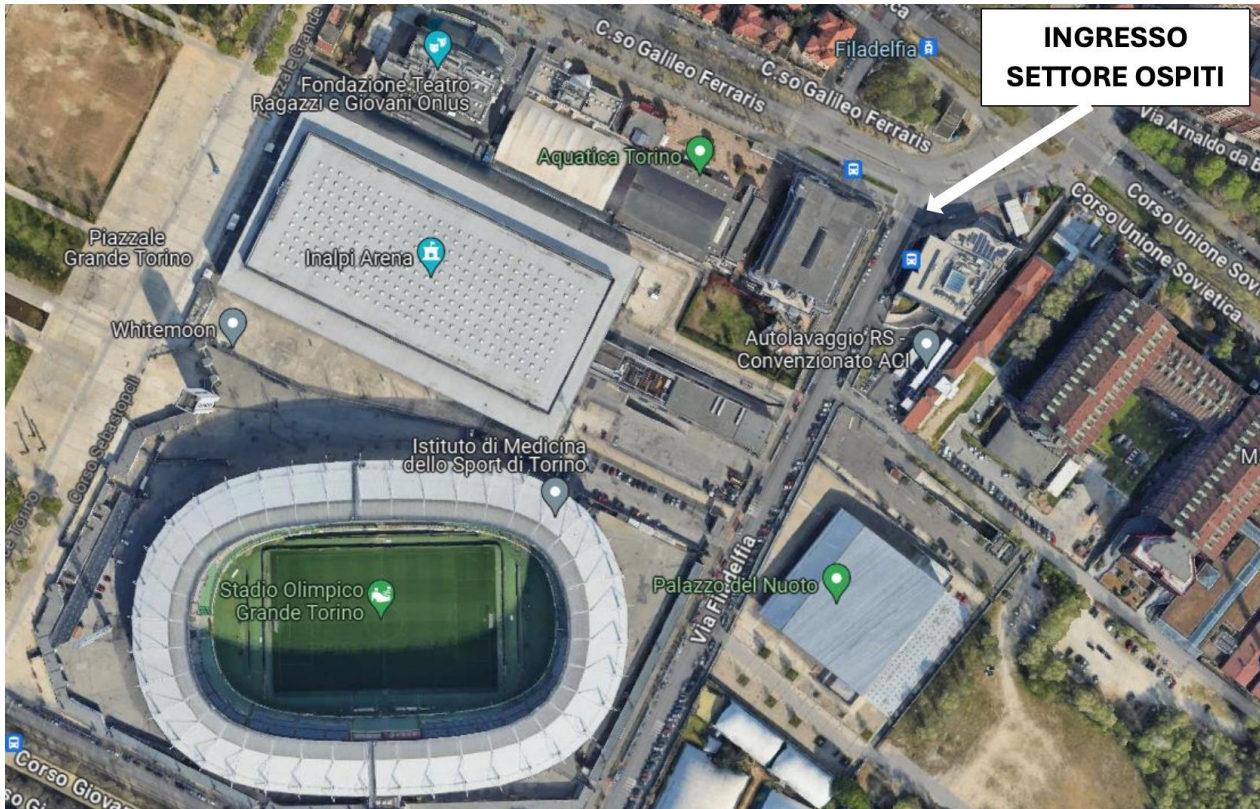

HOW TO GET TO THE STADIUM



AIRPLANE

Take the SFM train 26674 and get off at «Torino Porta Susa» (5 stops, 30 minutes).

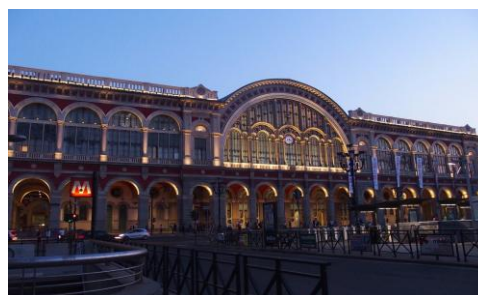
Walk 10 minutes to the green line 10 stop «Questura», direction «Mirafiori Sud, Corso Settembrini», and get off at «Sebastopoli» (9 stops, 15 minutes).

Walk 3 minutes towards the stadium.

TRAIN

From «Torino Porta Susa» (5 stops, 30 minutes), walk 10 minutes to the green line 10 stop «Questura», direction «Mirafiori Sud, Corso Settembrini», and get off at «Sebastopoli» (9 stops, 15 minutes).

Walk 3 minutes towards the stadium.



HIGHWAY

Take the Torino/Corso Orbassano exit from the A55.

Continue along Corso Orbassano, driving towards Corso Giovanni Agnelli.

Follow the parking instructions on page 6.



PARKING



At the guest entrance, a large trench parking area for buses will be set up in Via Filadelfia 96/B, Turin. Cars will be allowed to park inside the bus parking area only after all BUSES have been positioned and only if, at the end, there is still space available. If the space is full, a car-only parking area will be set up in **Piazza Caio Mario**, with a free shuttle service to and from the away section.



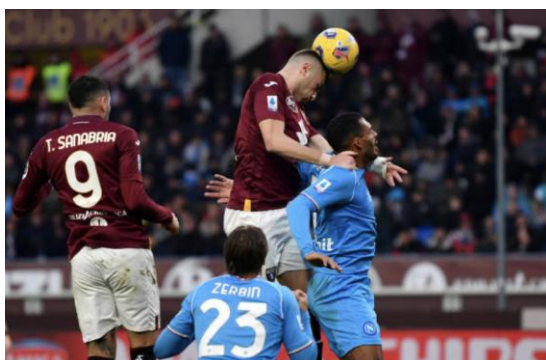

HOME TEAM



That of Torino is, in some ways, the very history of Italian football.

In the city of Turin, in fact, football arrived at the end of the nineteenth century, thanks to the initiative of Swiss and English industrialists, the real turning point for the team came on December 3, 1906, at the Voigt brewery (today Bar Norman) in Via Pietro Micca, there the Football Club Torino was founded, considered by many the oldest football club in Italy.

The first official match was played on December 16, 1906 in Vercelli against Pro Vercelli, 3-1 for the granata. The first season of the "Novo" era was a year of study. Defender Piacentini and center forward Franco Ossola arrived: Varese let him go for as much as 55,000 lire, a significant sum for the market of the time. After 15 years Torino won the championship again, the first of five consecutive titles. In the 1942/43 season the Toro also won the second Italian Cup with an unprecedented record: 5 victories in 5 matches against Anconetana, Atalanta, Milan, Roma and Venezia, 20 goals scored and 0 conceded.

The match against Benfica was a true friendly, the granata team defeated 4-3 with great applause for captain Ferreira who was retiring from football, in a stadium packed with forty thousand people... The following day, on May 4, the entire team boarded the three-engine plane I-Elce to return home, the weather was terrible with low clouds and pouring rain, after the last contact with the radio station, perhaps due to the bad weather or a fault in the altimeter, the plane crashed against the Basilica of Superga, shrouded in thick fog, it was 5:05 p.m. on May 4, 1949.

Novo still as president, restarted from the youth sector to prepare, in the 1949/50 season, a dignified Torino. It was in the 1975/76 season that the Granata, leaving their rival Juve second, would return to triumph with their 7th and last championship title.
