



New Built

For aesthetic & practical reasons the roof tiles are ideal for a new roof. They are considerably lighter than traditional clay and concrete tiles allowing a lighter roof structure to be considered.



Fibre cement sheets

For refurbishment of old roofs the JI roof tile is the ideal solution. In most cases the existing roof cladding can stay in place. Therefore saving demolition and disposal costs.



Renovation on butimen roofs

As the sheets come made to measure they ensure a quick and fast installation. They are fixed with self drilling screws (in the pan of the tile). The screws are colour matched to the roof tile. Dedicated tools are not required.
