This declaration accessibility applies to the AcMilan iOS App.

Compliance Status

Partially compliant.

This website is partially compliant with the requirements set out in Appendix A of the UNI CEI EN 301549 standard, due to the cases of non-compliance listed below.

Non-accessible Content

The content listed below is not accessible for the following reason: non-compliance with Law 9 January 2004, no. 4.

Below are the non-accessible contents that may cause difficulties for people with disabilities:

- C.11.1.1.1 – Some non-textual content presented to the user does not have a text alternative that serves the same purpose;
- C.11.1.3.1 – In some cases, information, structure, or relationships conveyed through page presentation cannot be programmatically determined (or are not available via text);
- C.11.1.3.3 – Some instructions provided to understand and operate content rely solely on sensory characteristics such as shape, color, size, visual location, orientation, or sound;
- C.11.1.3.4 – The display and functioning of certain content do not vary depending on the screen orientation;

- C.11.1.4.3 – The visual representation of text and images containing text does not always meet the minimum required contrast ratio, except in cases permitted by regulation;

- C.11.4.1.2 – In some cases, user interface components (including form elements, links, and script-generated components), names, roles, states, properties, and values are not correct or set, or users and their assistive technologies are not notified when these change;
- C.11.4.1.3 – In some cases, status messages are not presented to the user in a way that allows assistive technologies to interpret them without requiring a change of focus.
