HOW TO GET TO THE STADIUM



AIRPLANE

From Milan Malpensa Airport, take the Malpensa Express to Milan Central Station. From Milan Central Station take a train to Como S. Giovanni (about 40–45 min); from the station Como Stadium can be reached on foot in a few minutes.

TRAIN

For the visiting supporters arriving in Como by Ferrovie dello Stato train, stop Como San Giovanni, distance to the stadium 400 meters.

Ferrovie Nord stop Como Lago, distance to the stadium 700 meters.



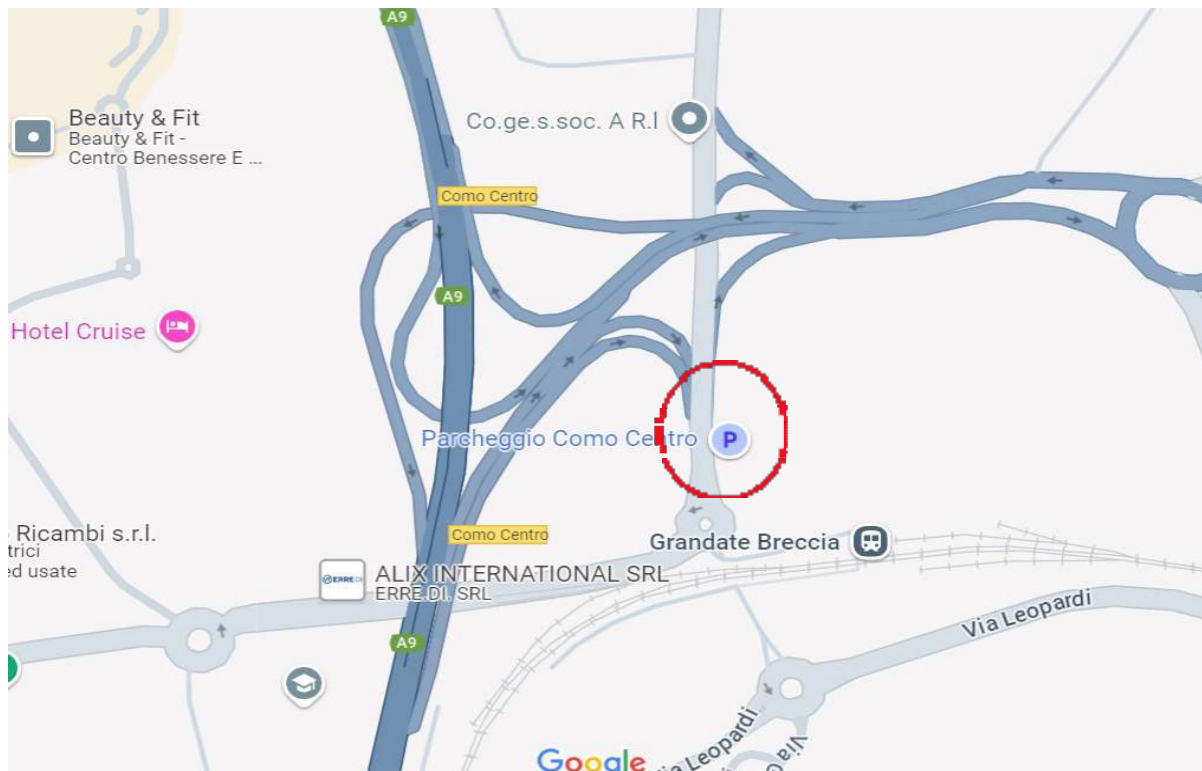
HIGHWAY

For visiting supporters arriving in Como from Milan, take the A9 motorway towards Como and exit at Como Centro.

Coaches and cars will be parked at “Parcheggio Como Centro” located in via Colombo, about 800 meters from the motorway exit.

Coaches and cars will be parked at “Parcheggio Como Centro” located in via Colombo, about 800 meters from the motorway exit.

Subsequently the supporters will be accompanied to the Giuseppe Sinigaglia stadium by shuttle buses. parking and shuttle service free of charge.

HOME TEAM



Como Calcio was officially founded in 1907 on the shores of the lake, when the ball was still a novelty and football had the scent of pioneers. After the first years among regional tournaments and minor leagues, Como began to make itself known on the national stage, alternating promotions and relegations between Serie B and Serie C, embodying from the very beginning the fighting spirit of a team that never gives up.

The dream of Serie A came true for the first time in 1949, but it was in the 1980s that Como experienced its brightest period: in the 1984-85 season a historic promotion to the top division arrived, guided by Eugenio Bersellini. In those years the blue shirt was worn by names destined to enter the memory of the fans, such as a young Gianfranco Zola, who took his first steps in top-level football right in Como.

Difficult years followed, marked by setbacks and new beginnings, until the bankruptcy of 2004 forced the club to start again from the amateur leagues. But as often happens on the lake, after the storm the calm returns: Como gradually climbed back up, changing ownership and identity several times, without ever losing its bond with the city. In 2019 the arrival of the new international ownership marked the beginning of a new era, defined by ambition and long-term planning. After decades of waiting, suffering and stories to tell, Como finally returns to dreaming big, with its eyes turned to the future but its heart firmly rooted in its history.
