Non-accessible Content

The contents listed below are not accessible due to non-compliance with Law 9 January 2004, no. 4.

Below are the non-accessible contents that may cause difficulties for people with disabilities:

- some functionalities are not reachable when navigating with a keyboard (9.2.1.1 9.2.4.2);
- in some pages, the purpose of certain links is sometimes missing (9.2.4.4);
- navigation with assistive technologies may be limited due to components not being detectable or usable, or due to missing start/end tags (9.4.1.1 9.4.1.2);
- in some elements, the focus indicator in the keyboard-accessible user interface is not visible (9.2.4.7);
- some elements do not receive focus in an order that preserves meaning and operability (9.2.4.2 9.2.4.3);
- some non-text content presented to the user does not have an equivalent text alternative serving the same purpose (9.1.1.1);

- in some cases, color is used as the only visual means to convey information or distinguish a visual element (9.1.4.1);

- on all pages, when zooming to 200%, the content does not adapt correctly (9.1.4.4);
- for pre-recorded audio-only and video-only media, unless they are provided as an alternative media type for clearly labeled textual content, no alternative is provided for the time-based media that conveys equivalent information (9.1.2.1 9.1.2.2 9.1.2.5);
- for some content, the purpose of each input field for user information cannot be programmatically determined (9.1.3.5);
- for some content implemented using markup languages that support the following text style properties, there may be loss of content or functionality (9.1.4.12);
- in some content, mouse pointer hover or keyboard focus does not reveal or hide content (9.1.4.13);
- the site does not provide a mechanism to skip blocks of content that repeat across multiple web pages (9.2.4.1);
- an operational mode in which the focus indicator is visible is not always available (9.2.4.7);
- navigation mechanisms that are repeated on multiple web pages within a set of web pages do not always appear in the same relative order each time they are repeated (9.3.2.3);
- labels or instructions are not always provided when content requires user input actions (9.3.3.2).
