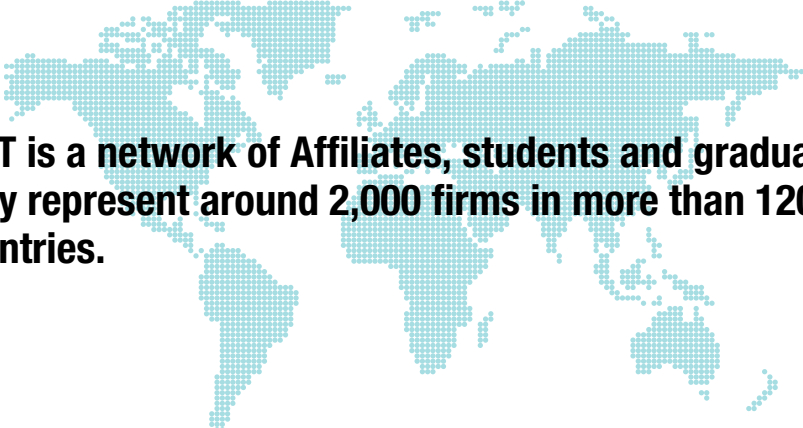
Build your professional identity
