Your study delay will be ½ year. The entry requirement for the second year course Practical Training: Psychological Research (PT:PR) is: having passed all first year courses. Therefore, PT:PR needs to be postponed to 2027-2028. Priority needs to be given to first year courses and second year courses that constitute an entry requirement for starting your specialisation courses in the second semester. This will give you a fulltime study load.
