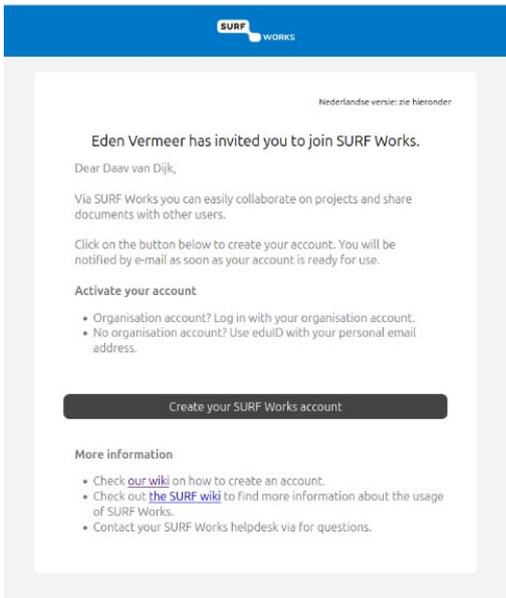


Step 1: Email in your inbox

You will receive an invitation from 'Surf Works notifications (no-reply@surf)'.

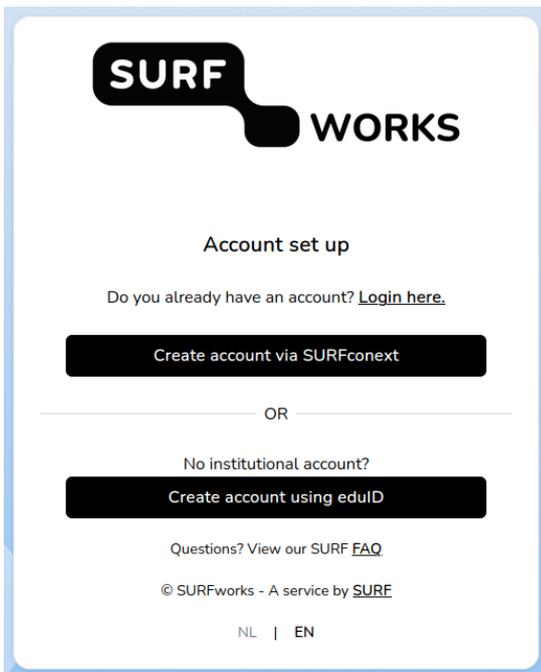

Step 2: Create your account

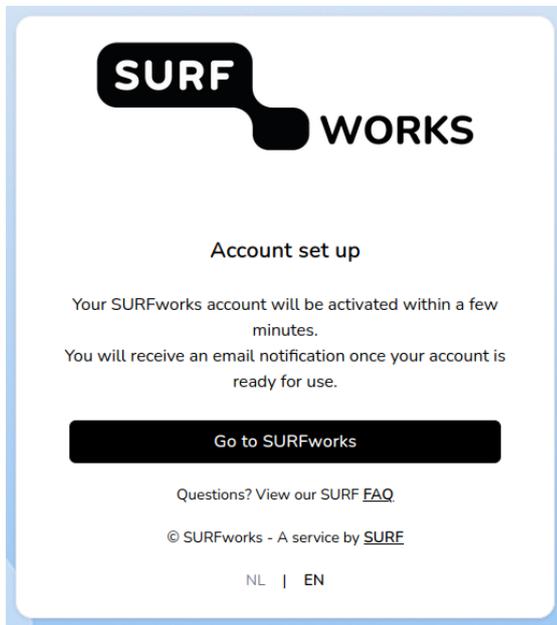
You get a pop-up screen in your browser.



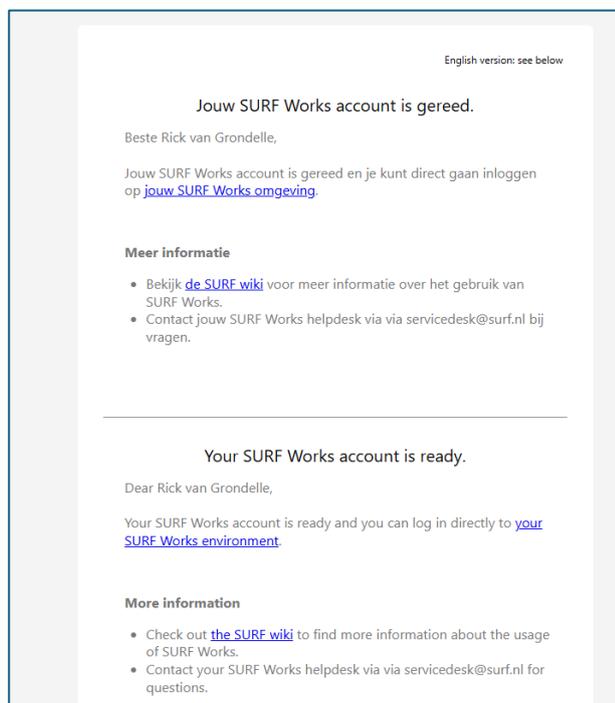
1. Click on the 'Create account via SURFconext' button.
2. Log in via SURFconext by selecting the UvA from the list. Log in with your UvAnetID.

Step 3: Access to the SURF Works environment

After logging in (via SURFconext), you will see a message indicating that your account is being activated. **Do not click on 'Go to SURFworks'. Wait for the email.**



When your account is ready, you will receive confirmation by email.



1. Click on the link in the email titled 'your SURF Works environment'.
2. Log in with the UvAnetID via SURFconext.
