

Terms and Conditions Short Term Programmes

1. The Executive Board of the University of Amsterdam reserves the right, assessing the health and safety situation, travel guidelines and the provision of on-site and online education, to terminate your participation in the Short Term Programme.
2. Your UvA Short Term offer does not mean full acceptance yet. You still need to apply directly to the host university. It is up to the host university to review your host university application and officially accept you as a short term student. Without their acceptance, you cannot participate in the Short Term Programme;
3. The host university has set out certain entry requirements, such as language proficiency and/or GPA. The host university may decide not to accept you if you do not meet their entry requirements. Your participation in the Short Term Programme will subsequently be cancelled;
4. If you wish to withdraw from the Short Term Programme, please contact the International Office of your faculty as soon as possible;
5. In the event that your Short Term Programme is cancelled by the University of Amsterdam, by the host university or by yourself, we will not be able to offer you an alternative exchange placement, nor will we be able to defer your placement to a different semester or academic year;
6. To prepare for the Short Term Programme, you are expected to read the information and follow the instructions as provided by the host university.
7. The terms of your Short Term Programme are non-negotiable; if you do not agree with these terms, you will not be able to participate in the Programme. Furthermore, you agree to comply with all rules and guidelines established by the University of Amsterdam and the host university.

8. You are required to be registered as a full-time and fee-paying student at the UvA for the entire time that you are participating in the Short Term Programme and that you pay your tuition accordingly;
9. You will act as an ambassador for the University of Amsterdam, representing the UvA while actively participating in the international student community abroad;
10. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs has four travel advisory levels: green, yellow, orange and red. You can find the travel advice for all areas and countries on <https://www.netherlandsworldwide.nl/>. If the advisory level for your Short Term Programme destination changes to orange or red during your stay abroad, you are expected to leave the host country and repatriate as soon as possible.

11. You are required to write a testimonial about your Short Term Programme experience which can be published on the UvA World Map. You can also be asked to participate in information meetings or to share your study abroad experience in another way.
