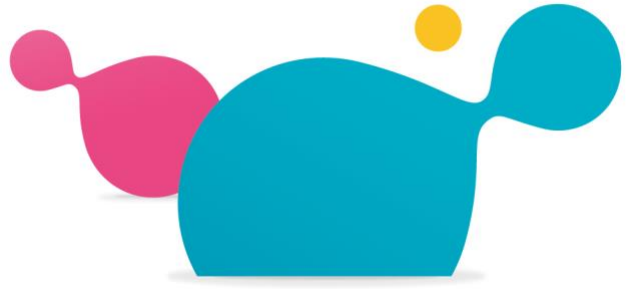

Knab posts €117.9 million profit in 2024

Amsterdam, 19 June 2025 – Knab closed 2024 with a net profit of €117.9 million. That's slightly lower than in 2023 (€134.4 million), mainly due to shifts in the interest rate climate, which impacted our interest margin. This drop was partly offset by higher income from services.

Growth in customers and brand recognition

Knab continues to grow as the bank for the self-employed. In 2024, more than 20,000 new primary banking customers joined us.
