FEATURES

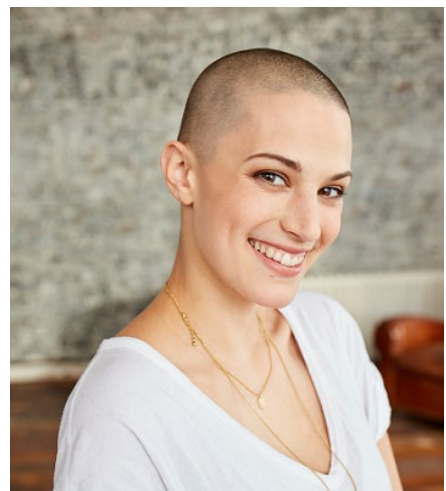
Routinely DKMS Germany, US, Poland, UK, Chile, India and South Africa inquire about the patient's health 3 months after transplant. For US patients the first update is provided after 9 months. If donors are interested and patient agrees, DKMS provides this information to the donors.

Engraftment data and further information about adverse events which are necessary for the Collection Center are also requested and then forwarded to them. A reminder to the TC will be sent if the completed questionnaire has not been received.
