Many retired members have decided to stay active in the union and a number of retired branches have been established in divisional councils. There is also a national Retired Members' Self Organised Group which meets regularly and campaigns on a wide range of issues including safeguarding and improving pensioners' conditions.

By staying on as a retired TSSA member, you get the following benefits:

- Ease of payment through direct debit
- You will be able to keep in touch with colleagues and your industry
- You will have access to legal services
