\*\*'AER' stands for the Annual Equivalent Rate and shows what the interest rate would be if interest was paid and added to your account each year.

## Definitions:

A "Deposit" is defined as a minimum investment of £1.

"Annual Anniversary" means 12 months from the day we receive your initial Deposit. and each subsequent 12-month period thereafter, for the purposes of calculating the annual interest payment.

A "Calendar Month" is defined as one of the months as named in the calendar.

"Maximum Monthly Deposit" means a deposit limit of £500 per Calendar Month.

## Product Special Conditions

These Product Special Conditions and the Manchester Building Society Savings General Terms and Conditions will apply effective from the date of account opening. In the event of a conflict, these Product Special Conditions will prevail.

- This account can only be opened by individuals who are 16 years old and over.
- This account can only be held in a single name.
- You may only hold one Manchester Regular Saver (Issue 1) account at any time.
- This account is of limited issue and may be withdrawn to new applicants at any time and without notice.
- Deposits may only be made from a nominated bank or building society account in your name.
- After placing your initial Deposit, you can make additional Deposits. There is no limit on the number of Deposits you can make per Calendar Month, however the total amount deposited must not exceed £500 in any one Calendar Month.
- If you Deposit more than £500 in any one Calendar Month; the payment which causes you to exceed the Maximum Monthly Deposit limit will be rejected and returned to the payment source in full.
- To ensure that your Deposit is received and credited to your account within the same Calendar Month, you must ensure that your Deposit is made and received by us within the same Calendar Month.
- Withdrawals/transfers to another account can only be made to Manchester Building Society easy access account in your name or nominated bank or building society account in your name.
