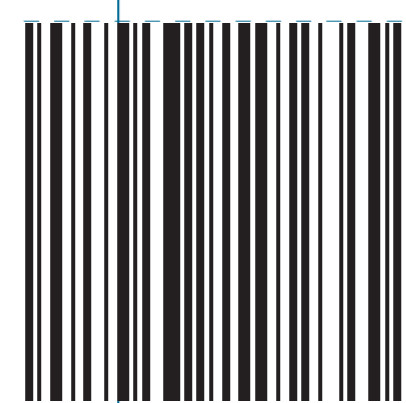

**Safety Precautions and Directions**  
Wash hands and exposed skin thoroughly after handling. Do not eat, drink or smoke while using this product. Do not breathe dust. Use only outdoors in a well-ventilated area. Wear protective gloves, protective clothing, eye and face protection. Store locked up in a well-ventilated place. Keep container tightly closed.

**First Aid**  
If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand.  
IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764766) or a doctor. Rinse mouth. Do not induce vomiting.  
IF INHALED: Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Call the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764766) or a doctor.  
IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately call the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764766) or a doctor.

**Environmental Protection**

**Emergency Response**

**Disposal**  
Preferably dispose of product by use. Otherwise dispose of product and packaging at an approved landfill or other approved facility. Burn empty packaging, if circumstances such as wind direction permit. Otherwise bury in a suitable landfill.

**MIXING AND FEEDING DIRECTIONS**  
**IMPORTANT: MUST BE THOROUGHLY MIXED IN FEEDS BEFORE USE.**

By law the user must take due care, obtaining expert advice when necessary, to avoid unnecessary pain and distress when using the product other than as directed on the label.

**Mixing Directions:**  
Thoroughly mix 500-625g of Maxiban Premix in one tonne to provide 40-50g narasin activity and 40-50g of nicarbazin activity per tonne of complete feed.

**Feeding Directions:**  
Broilers: Feed continuously as the only ration for at least 14-28 days.

**CONTRAINDICATIONS:**  
Poultry consuming narasin should not be treated with products containing tiamulin or oleandomycin. Severe growth depression may occur.

**CAUTION:**  
Do not allow horses or other equines access to feeds containing narasin. Ingestion by horses has been fatal. Do not feed to game birds.

**It is an offence for users of this product to cause residues exceeding the relevant MRL in the NZ (Maximum Residues of Agricultural Compounds) Food Standard.**

**WITHHOLDING PERIOD:**

**Meat: Nil**  
Eggs from treated birds must not be sold for human consumption for 10 days following the cessation of last treatment.

**STORAGE:**  
Avoid moisture and excessive heat.
