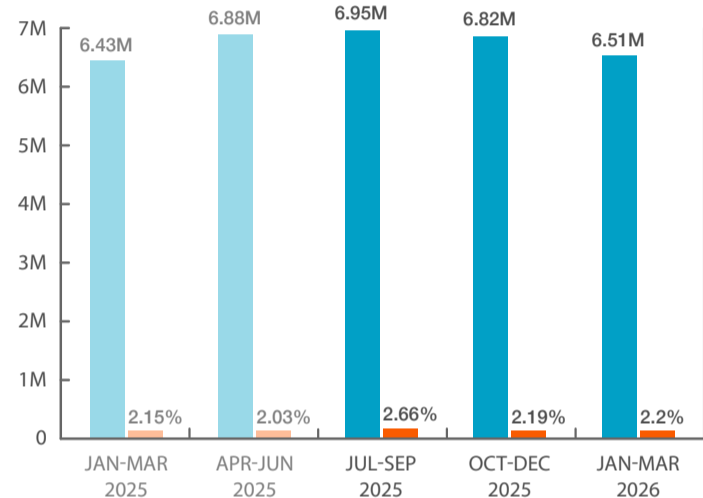
DURING JANUARY TO MARCH 2026:

- **BUSIEST JANUARY – MARCH PERIOD EVER** – 6.51 million journeys were made over the Mersey Gateway and Silver Jubilee Bridges in January – March 2026, making it the busiest first quarter ever
- **SILVER JUBILEE BRIDGE BREAKS NEW QUARTERLY RECORD** – with over 1.14 million journeys made between January – March 2026
- **MORE CUSTOMERS THAN EVER CHOOSING TO REGISTER WITH MERSEYFLOW AND USE THE AUTO-TOP UP SYSTEM** – shown by 94% of customers using digital or automated payment methods
- **PCNs STAY CONSISTENT AS A % OF OVERALL JOURNEYS** – 97.8% of journeys were paid for on time

All revenue, either from tolls/charges or PCNs, contributes towards payment for the Mersey Gateway Bridge.

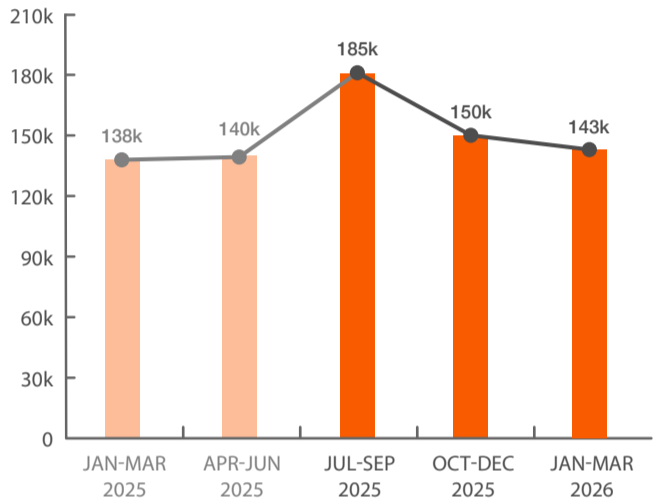
Traffic increases year on year

Total journeys and number of PCNs issued



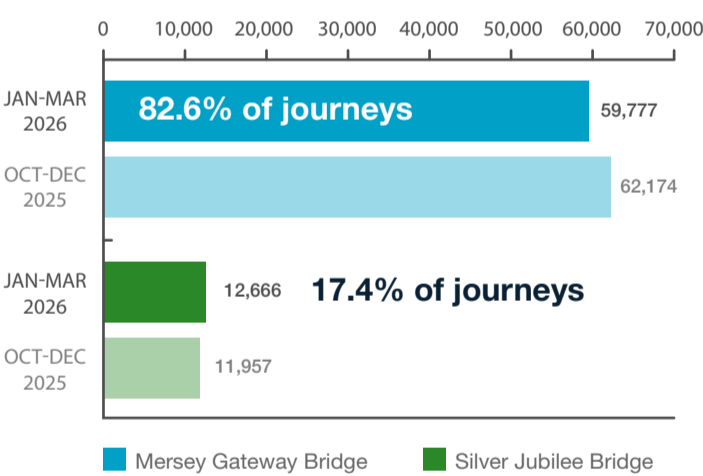
PCNs steady at 2.2% of journeys

PCNs issued



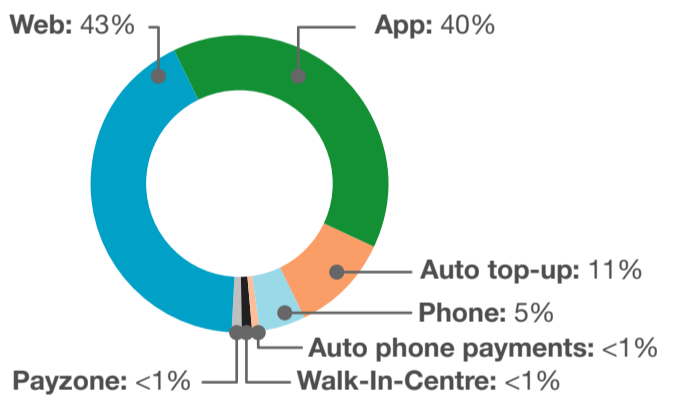
Bridge usage from January – March 2026

97.8% of customers paid their toll/charge on time

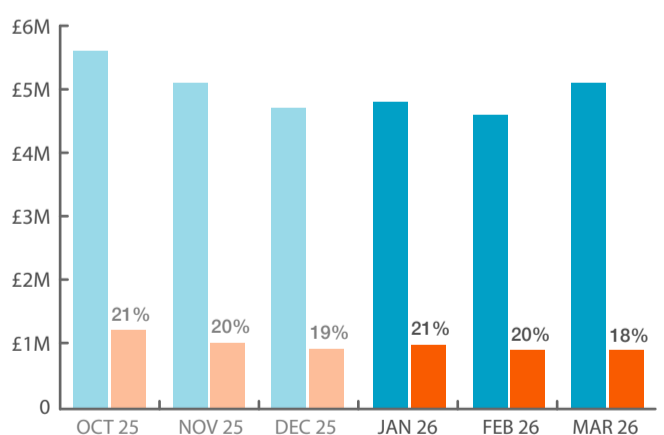
