JULY TO SEPTEMBER 2024

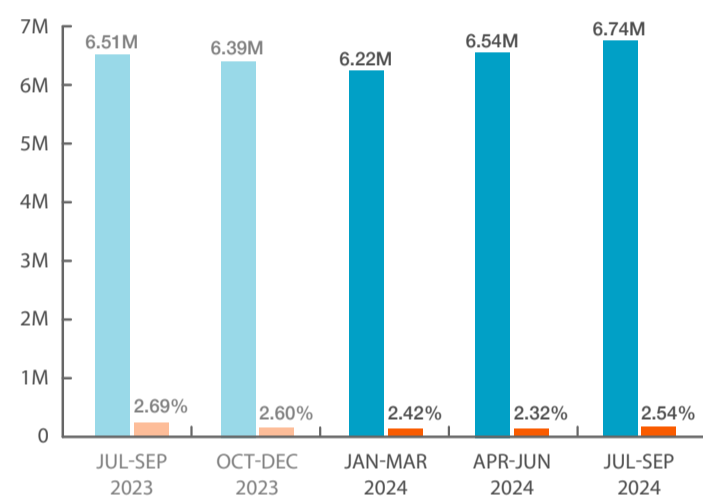
DURING JULY TO SEPTEMBER 2024:

- **MOST JOURNEYS EVER RECORDED ACROSS THE RIVER IN HALTON** – over 6.74 million journeys were made over the Mersey Gateway and Silver Jubilee Bridges between July - September 2024, with July the busiest month on record
- **OVER 81,000 VEHICLES USING THE BRIDGES EVERY WEEKDAY** – with over 86% of vehicles using the Mersey Gateway Bridge to cross the river
- **MORE CUSTOMERS CHOOSING TO REGISTER WITH MERSEYFLOW AND USE THE AUTO TOP-UP SYSTEM THAN EVER** – shown by over 93% of customers using digital or automated payment methods
- **PCNs REMAIN CONSISTENT AS A % OF OVERALL JOURNEYS** – over 97.4% of journeys were paid for on time

All revenue, either from tolls/charges or PCNs, contributes towards payment for the Mersey Gateway Bridge.

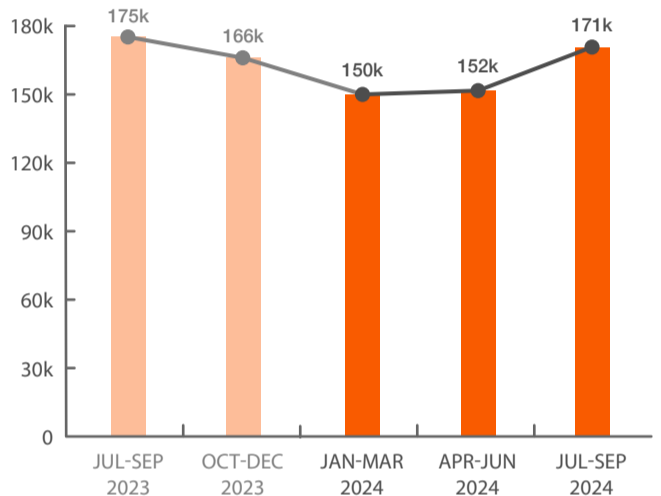
Record quarterly journey numbers

Total journeys and number of PCNs issued



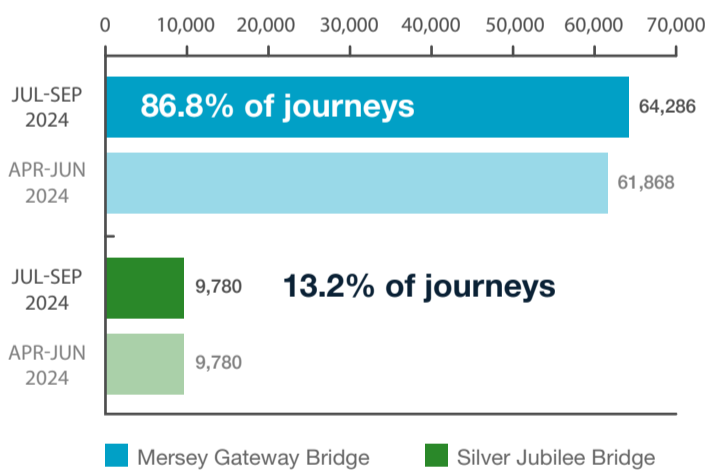
PCNs remain consistent

PCNs issued



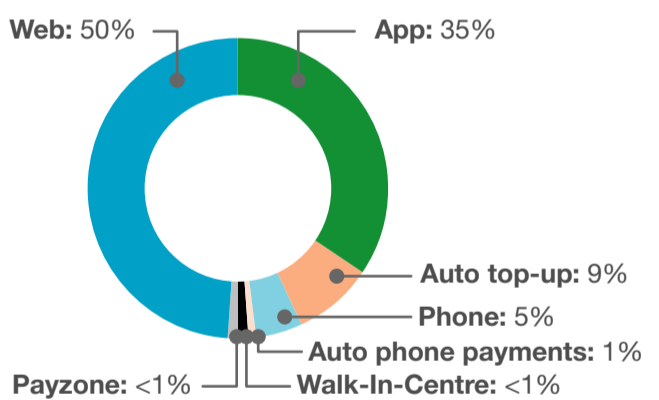
Bridge usage from July – September 2024

Over 93% of payments made via digital or automated channels

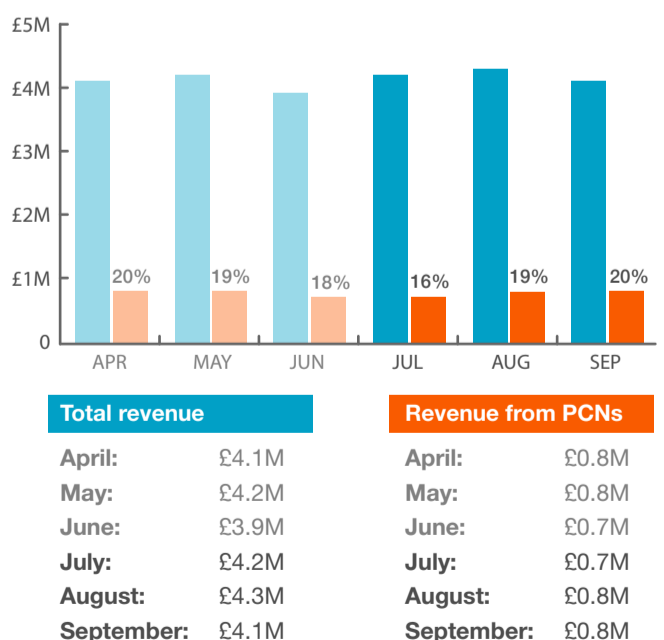


Total journeys and Penalty Charge Notices (PCNs)
