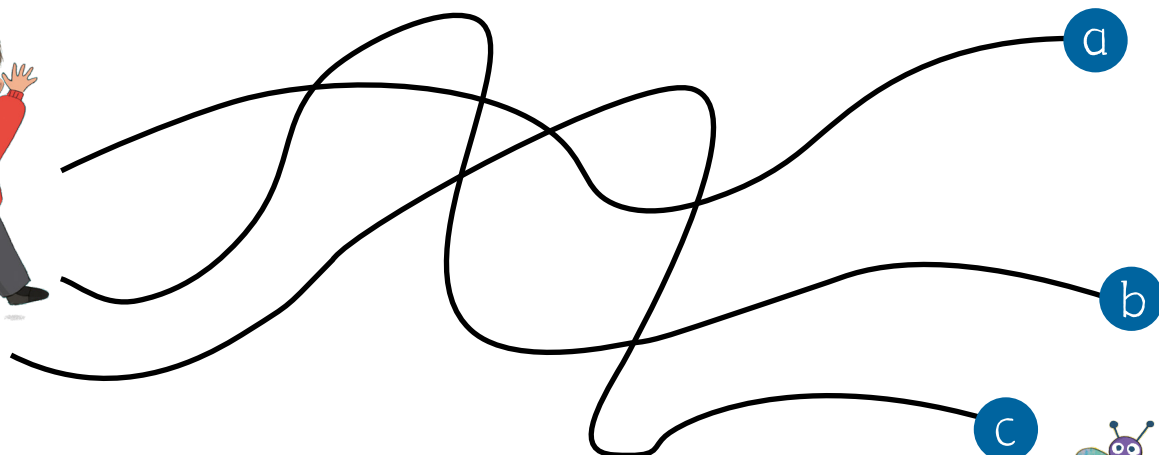

Roo is looking for a new friend to play with, can you help? Follow the path that leads the way.



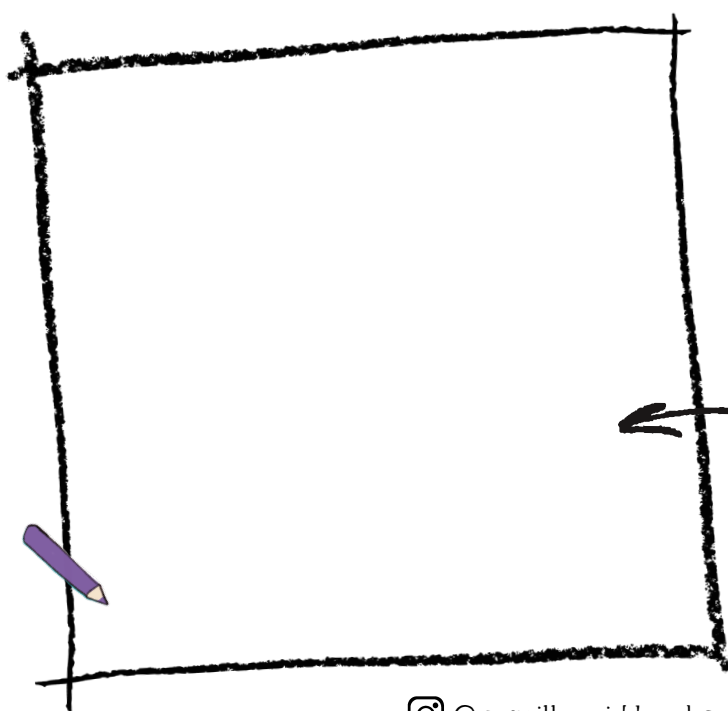
Magic Words

Have relaxed chats about the classroom and air any worries





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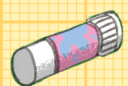


Get ready for school with this fun wall planner.
