



Ears for a Rabbit or a Hare

A twitchy White Rabbit or a mad March Hare? You choose!

You will need:

Two sheets of A4 card
(white card for the Rabbit
or brown card for the
March Hare)

Pink card or paper

Scissors

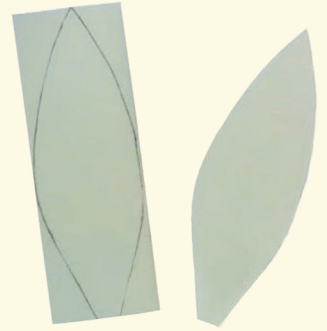
Glue

Double-sided sticky tape

Pencil

What to do:

1. Make a headband by cutting the first sheet of white or brown card into two strips, about 5–6cm wide. Tape these together into one long strip.
2. Ask someone to help you fit the strip around the top of your head, tight enough that it won't fall down. Make a pencil mark where the card joins, then take it off your head and glue the headband together. Make it extra secure with a couple of strips of tape.
3. Trace over the ears on page 45 onto tracing paper.
4. Now draw over the ears on the tracing paper onto the second sheet of card. Cut the ears out of the card.

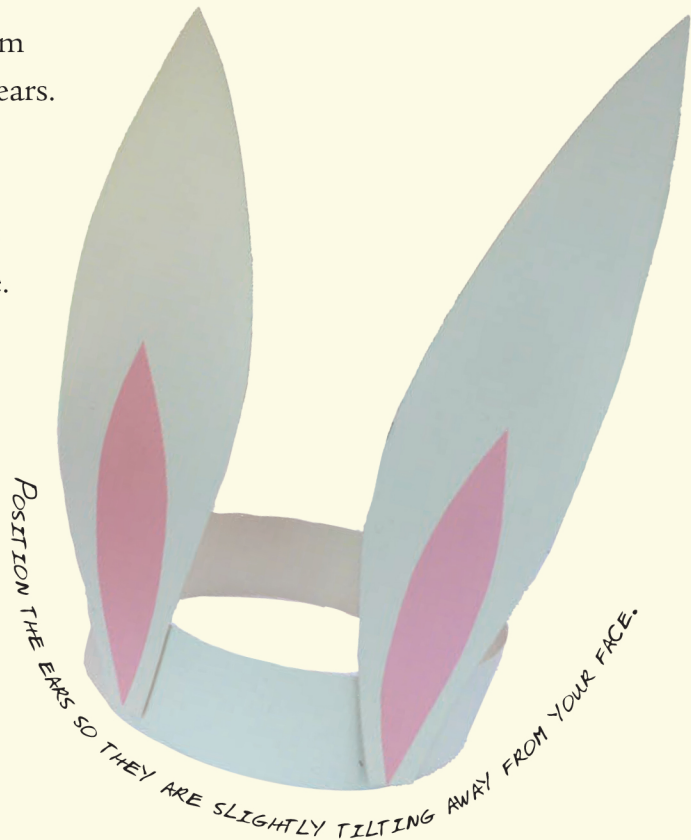


5. Cut out two smaller ear shapes from the pink card for the inside of the ears. Glue these pieces onto the ears.
6. Stick the ears to the outside of the headband using glue or sticky tape.

Using face paints, paint on a pink or black nose and round white cheeks with black dots and black whiskers. For the March Hare, add a colourful bow tie and a jacket or waistcoat. If you are a White Rabbit, wear your ears with a white t-shirt, white leggings or trousers, and a waistcoat.
