Stevie Chadwick, Community Development Officer - I reached out to Tori about a year ago. When I saw that they were fundraising to start up their teens and kids groups for neurodiverse individuals and their families. So what I did with that is, I offered them £1,000 funding to help get the group starting up, and then from there on I've had a relationship with Tori and the Koala Community Hub and helping them to receive some external funding to help the group grow.

I reached out to Tori back at the beginning of the year when #iwill was launched and to let them know about the opportunity to receive funding for a social action project. Tori took up this idea and luckily they were successful with the grant. And, as you can see, they are now operating a social action group.
