

# Highfield Level 3 End-Point Assessment for Safety, Health and Environment (SHE) Technician (IfATE v1.2/v1.3)



Government funding band – £5,000



On-programme duration – typically 24 months



Gateway requirements – apprentices must have achieved level 2 English and level 2 maths, submitted a portfolio of evidence and submitted a project scope



End-point assessment method – knowledge exam, project report and presentation with questioning, and professional discussion underpinned by portfolio of evidence

## An overview of the standard

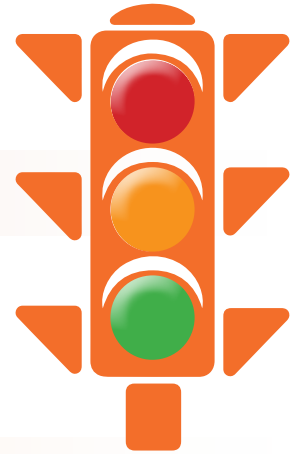
A SHE technician will be able to work in organisations of varying sizes and in various industries. The technician will work with the management and delivery team of the organisation to advise on the statutory health, safety and environmental requirements as they affect the company's operations. They will assist the management team in ensuring that the legal and company SHE requirements are implemented. On a daily basis the SHE technician will assist to develop, review and check on the implementation of safe systems of work, deliver training (e.g. toolbox talks and inductions), investigate incidents, analyse data and present findings to the management team. The SHE technician will engage with all aspects of the organisation to support the implementation of a culture that ensures everyone is able to return to their family and friends unharmed every day while also protecting and enhancing land, air and water resources for future generations.

## The programme's structure

Apprentices will be placed in a role over 24 months during which they will be supported while on-programme by their tutor. The tutor will review the progress of the apprentice against the standard to ensure they are prepared for the end-point assessment.



## Your apprentice's journey



### Ready for training

- Initial assessment
- English and maths training
- On-programme training to meet the requirements of the standard
- Gateway readiness self-assessment

### Set for assessment on completion of training and functional skills

#### Knowledge exam

- 60-minute test consisting of 40 multiple-choice questions

#### Project report and presentation with questioning

- The project report will be 3,000 words (+/- 10%)
- The apprentice will present evidence from their real work
- The presentation with questioning will last 40 minutes, typically including a 20-minute presentation followed by 20 minutes of questioning

#### Professional discussion underpinned by portfolio of evidence

- The professional discussion will last up to 60 minutes
- It will be underpinned by the portfolio of evidence submitted at gateway
- It will be audio recorded for quality assurance purposes
