## Working as a hire controller

The broad purpose of the occupation is to offer a service to both commercial and domestic customers to hire plant, tools and equipment (PTE) on short or long-term hire to carry out specific tasks. It provides specialist plant, tools, machinery or equipment. In their daily work, an employee in this occupation interacts with a wide range of different stakeholders. The hire controller is key to the success of their organisation and one of the main points of contact for the customers.

This occupation is found in construction and other sectors including mechanical, electrical, facilities management and civil engineering.

## The programme's structure

Your apprentice will be placed in a role, during which they will be supported while on-programme by their tutor. Their tutor will review the progress of the apprentice against the standard to ensure they are prepared for the end-point assessment.

### Set for assessment

End-point assessment methods are:

#### Multiple-choice test:

- A 45-minute multiple-choice test consisting of 30 questions

#### Interview underpinned by a portfolio of evidence:

- A 60-minute interview
- Portfolio of evidence submitted at gateway, which is not directly assessed
- A minimum of 8 questions asked during the interview
