

Highfield **Level 5** End-Point Assessment for **Children, Young People and Families Manager**



Government funding band – **£6,000**



On-programme duration – **Typically 24-30 months**
(12 to 18 months for experienced managers)



Gateway requirements – **Portfolio submitted, current DBS certificate, Level 5 Diploma in Leadership and Management for Residential Childcare or Level 5 Diploma in Leadership for Health and Social Care, Level 2 math and English.**



End-point assessment method – **Situational judgement test and competence interview**

Overview of the standard:

A Children, Young People and Families Manager ensures direction, alignment and commitment within their own practice and their team and organisation to help children, young people and families to do their best and achieve sustainable change.

The programme's structure

There are 2 pathways to the Children Young People and Families Manager. The apprentice will be placed in either a children's residential care role or as a manager within the community role, depending on the chosen pathway. This will typically last 24-30 months during which they will be supported while on-programme by their tutor. Their tutor will review the progress of the apprentice during this period against the standard to ensure they are prepared for the end-point assessment.

Your apprentice's journey



Ready for training

- Initial assessment
- English and math training
- On-programme training to meet the requirements of the standard
- Gateway readiness self-assessment

Set for assessment on completion of training and functional skills

End-point assessment methods are:

Competence interview

- 55-65-minute interview between the end-point assessor and apprentice, focusing on the work covered in the portfolio

Situational judgement test

- 2-hour duration
- 9-scenario based questions, 7 questions per theme and 2 questions per pathway
- the test assesses the apprentice's knowledge outlined in the standard.
