

End-Point Assessment for

ST0550 Safety, Health and Environment (SHE) Technician v1.2

Level 3

Working as a safety, health and environment technician

A SHE technician will be able to work in organisations of varying sizes and in various industries. The technician will work with the management and delivery team of the organisation to advise on the statutory health, safety and environmental requirements as they affect the company's operations. They will assist the management team in ensuring that the legal and company SHE requirements are implemented. On a daily basis the SHE technician will assist to develop, review and check on the implementation of safe systems of work, deliver training (e.g. toolbox talks and inductions), investigate incidents, analyse data and present findings to the management team. The SHE technician will engage with all aspects of the organisation to support the implementation of a culture that ensures everyone is able to return to their family and friends unharmed every day while also protecting and enhancing land, air and water resources for future generations.

Gateway requirements

Level 2 in English and maths (optional for 19+, please see funding rules), submitted organisation's policies and procedures, and submission of a portfolio of evidence & project scope

End-point assessment methods

Knowledge test, project report and presentation with questioning and professional discussion underpinned by a portfolio of evidence

Ready for training

- Initial assessment
 - English and maths training (optional for 19+, please see funding rules)
 - On-programme training to meet the requirements of the standard
 - Gateway readiness self-assessment

End-point assessment methods are:

Knowledge test:

- 60 minute test consisting of 40 multiple-choice questions

Project report and presentation with questioning:

- The project report will be 3,000 words (+/-10%)
- The apprentice will present evidence from their real work
- The presentation with questioning will last 40 minutes (+10%), typically including a 20-minute presentation followed by 20 minutes of questioning

Professional discussion underpinned by portfolio:

- A 60-minute professional discussion (+10%)
 - Portfolio of evidence submitted at gateway
 - It will be audio recorded for quality assurance purposes
