Dry Film Thickness

PPG Industries, Inc. certifies the following performance properties for the DURANAR® Coil & Extrusion Coating Systems when applied and baked on properly cleaned and pretreated substrates, according to PPG specifications:

Specification:	Instruments covered by this test method measure coating thickness by the use of eddy currents. The instrument must be calibrated in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions before using. The instrument probe must be placed directly on the coating surface to take a reading. Three readings are suggested per 3 in. by 6 in. area to characterize the sample.
Result:	The nominal dry film thickness for the DURANAR® 2-coat system is 0.20 mils of primer and 0.75 mils of topcoat totaling 0.95 mils. Each coating layer can be specified at the nominal dry film thickness +/- 0.05 mils.
