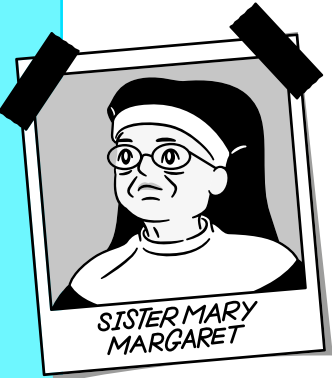


WHODUNIT!

Use the information and clues uncovered from Mae's detective logbook to figure out **who** took the walking stick, **where** they hid it, and **what time** the crime happened!



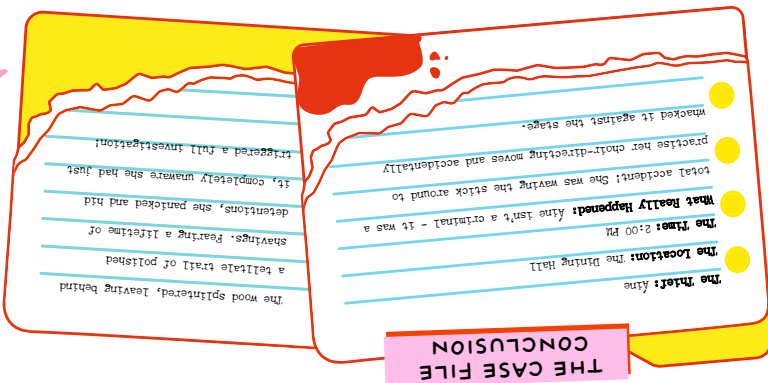

Keep going around until only one item is left in each category!




PLOT REVEAL!
