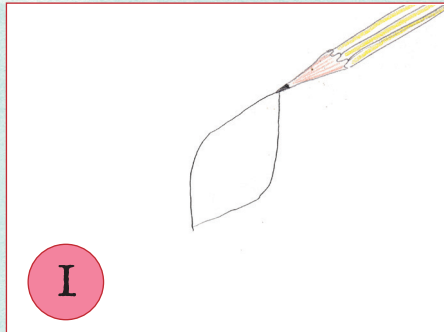
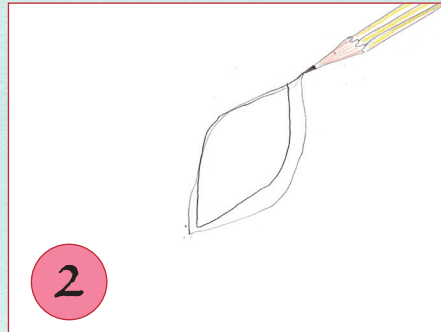


# Draw your own Go-Away Bird!

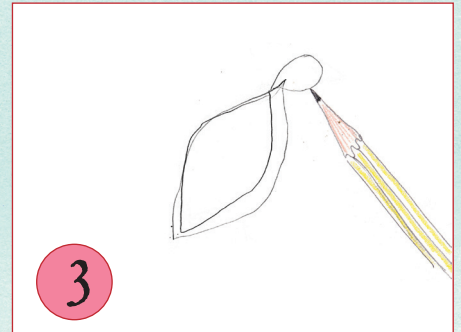
Would you like to draw the Go-Away Bird? Just follow these 9 simple steps.



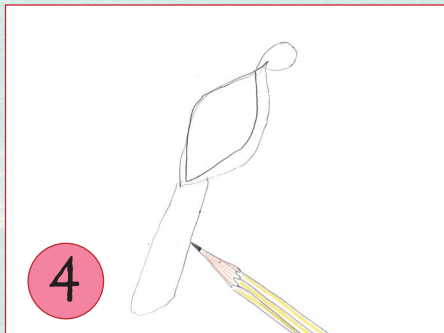
Using a pencil, draw a wobbly leaf shape. This is the wing of your bird.



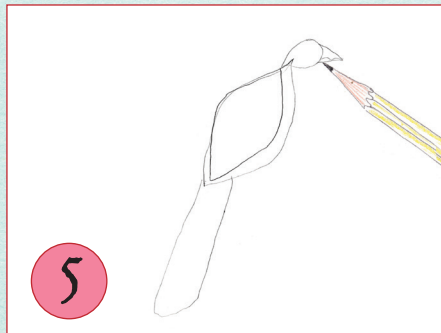
Draw a bigger wobbly leaf shape around the first one you drew. This is your bird's body.



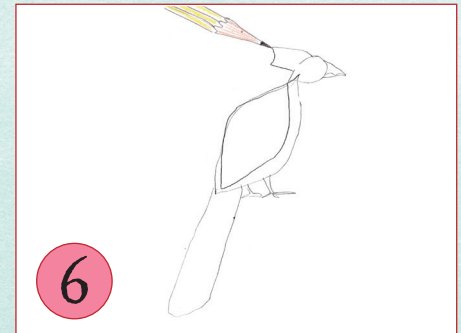
At the top of your shape, draw an oval for your bird's head.



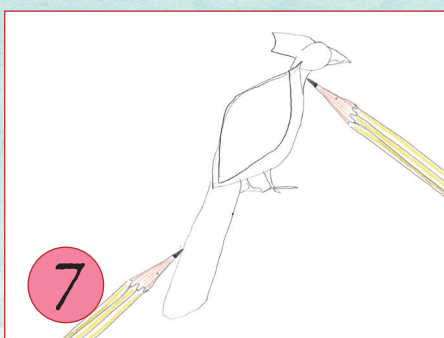
Now it's time to create the tail! Draw a long, thin rectangle at the bottom of the body.



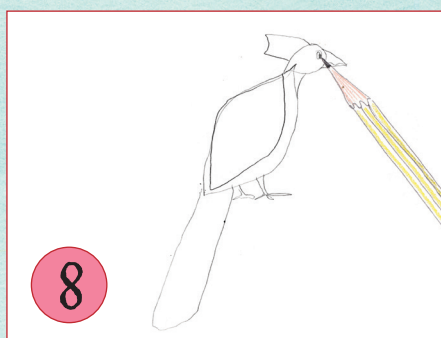
Add a beak to the head of the bird so she can squawk "Go-Away!" at the other birds!



Add the crest to the top of her head by drawing another rectangle shape opposite her beak.



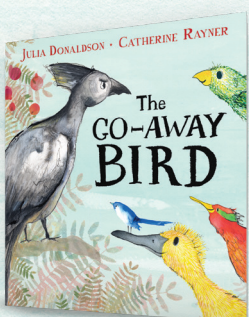
Add the bird's legs and feet underneath her body. Now finish the Go-Away bird's head by adding in a line to create her neck.



Now draw her eye – if you want to make her look cross, you can add a stern eyebrow. But you can make her happy if you would like by leaving out the eyebrow and giving her a smile.



Now it's time to colour her in. The Go-Away Bird looks grey but she has lots of other colours in her feathers too! Can you see the blue, yellow and purple?

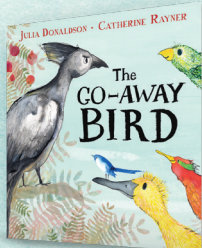
