


## Understanding your Royalty Statement Pack

Your new Royalty Statement pack is comprised of the following sections:

- **Summary/Remittance Advice** shows the balance due to be paid or carried forward at the end of the current period by contract
- **Royalty Statement Summary or Self Billed Invoice** summarises activity in the current period per contract.
- **Royalty Detailed Statement** shows a detailed breakdown of any Royalties activity in the current period. Future statements, for contracts where the first activity occurs after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020, will also show cumulative net copies and earnings.
- **Subsidiary Rights Income Statement** shows a detailed breakdown of any income received in the period in respect of subsidiary rights sold. Future statements, for contracts where the first activity occurs after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020, will also show cumulative net copies.
