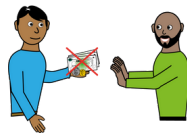

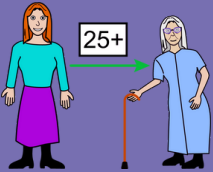

Turning Point Wakefield Inspiring Recovery is a drug and alcohol prevention, treatment and recovery service.



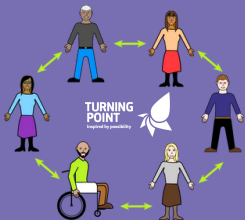
Our services can be used by anyone over the age of 25 in the Wakefield District.

Everyone we support has a dedicated recovery worker, who will help you find your path to recovery.

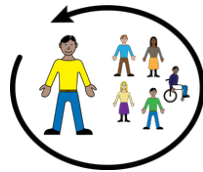
We offer different types of support across the Wakefield District. We have several hubs where you can visit us, and we also have smaller sites in the community.
