60 credits from the specified compulsory module in design and 60 credits from the further specified compulsory modules

or

60 credits from the specified compulsory module in design and 60 credits from the core option modules

Stage 2 (120 credits)

60 credits from the specified compulsory module in design and 60 credits from a further specified compulsory module

or

60 credits from the specified compulsory module in design and 60 credits from the core option modules

Stage 3 (120 credits)

60 credits from the specified compulsory module and depending on the pathway being followed, 60 credits from the specified compulsory module(s) or from the specified core option modules

Maximum transferred credit

240 credits at Stage 1 and Stage 2

Maximum age of credit transfer

16 years

Unique study requirement

120 credits at OU Stage 3
