Entry Requirements

Students will be expected to have an Honours degree in any subject. Your spoken and written English must be of an adequate standard for postgraduate study. 180 credits from three compulsory 60-credit modules

120 credits*

60 credits

Classification

Distinction: At least 90* module credits at Distinction grade, including the dissertation module.

Merit: At least 90* module credits at Merit grade, including the dissertation module.

Additional rules

* Minimum classification requirements will require completion of two 60-credit modules. Students with 120 credits of credit transfer will receive an unclassified award.
