### Maximum duration of study

16 years, except where credit transfer has been awarded, in which case the time to complete the OU credit will be as follows:

240 credits to complete– 8 years

270 credits to complete– 9 years

300 credits to complete– 10 years

330 credits to complete– 11 years

360 credits to complete– 12 years

390 credits to complete – 13 years

420 credits to complete – 14 years

450 credits to complete – 15 years

**Maximum transferred credit**

240 credits at OU Stages 1 and 2

**Maximum age of credit transfer**

5 years

**Unique study requirement**

180 credits at OU Stage 3 and above, but see Additional rules.

**Additional rules**

Credit from a completed BEng cannot be used towards the MEng.
