## How is the qualification assessed?

This qualification is assessed by a multiple-choice question examination. This method of assessment is an end-of-course exam and must follow the Highfield Qualifications Examination and Invigilation Procedures. The examination for this qualification contains 30 questions that must be completed within 1 hour. Successful learners must achieve a score of at least 20 out of 30 (66%). Learners will achieve a Distinction at 24 out of 30 (80%).
