



## Accessibility Declaration for the Speck Alto Adige PGI website

The Speck Alto Adige Consortium is committed to making its website accessible, in accordance with Law No. 4 of 9 January 2004.

This accessibility declaration applies to the website <https://www.speck.it/en>.

### Compliance status

#### Partially compliant

This website is partially compliant with the requirements set out in Appendix A of the UNI CEI EN 301549 standard, due to the non-compliance cases listed below.

**Accessibility percentage: 81.82%**

### Non-accessible content

The content listed below is not accessible for the following reason:

a) **non-compliance with Law No. 4 of 9 January 2004.**

- Non-text content (WCAG 1.1.1): some images and interactive controls are not accompanied by adequate text descriptions in the language of the displayed page.
- Info and relationships (WCAG 1.3.1): some interactive components do not correctly communicate their structure and the relationships between elements to assistive technologies.
- Minimum contrast (WCAG 1.4.3): the colours of some text do not ensure an adequate contrast ratio against the background.
- Bypass blocks (WCAG 2.4.1): a skip-to-main-content link is missing, forcing users to navigate through all navigation elements.
- Link purpose in context (WCAG 2.4.4): some links are not descriptive and do not provide sufficient information about the linked action or content.
- Label in name (WCAG 2.5.3): the programmatic labels of some interactive components do not match the visible text, preventing activation via voice commands.
- Language of parts (WCAG 3.1.2): some labels and interface texts are not translated into the language of the displayed page.
- Name, role, value (WCAG 4.1.2): not all controls and menus correctly communicate their state and function to assistive technologies.
- PDF documents: some documents published in the Downloads section are not accessible and do not present an adequate semantic structure for reading with assistive technologies.

The Speck Alto Adige Consortium is committed to taking the necessary actions to resolve the issues identified and to make the website fully compliant with accessibility standards. The interventions are planned and will be implemented progressively.
