



STUDENT TERM-TIME LINKS TICKET

TERMS & CONDITIONS AND GUIDELINES

Student Term-Time Links Tickets are available to eligible students to provide access from 01 September to 31 May.

Full-time students at the University of St Andrews are eligible to purchase a ticket which allows unlimited play over 7-days on the courses included within the criteria of the ticket, from 01 September to 31 May of the following year. The ticket can be renewed annually while still a full-time St Andrews University student.

EXPLANATION OF TICKET OPTIONS

There are three options for access and play for Term-Time 2026/27:

A Full ticket gives access to all courses; Old Course, The Castle Course, New Course, Jubilee Course, Eden Course, Strathtyrum Course, Balgove Course and The Craigtoun Course.

A Restricted ticket gives access to all courses except the Old Course and The Castle Course.

The Strathtyrum & Balgove ticket gives access to the Strathtyrum Course and 9-hole Balgove Course only.

HOW TO APPLY – NEW APPLICANTS

To apply for a ticket please complete the **application form** and email to yearlytickets@standrews.com including a copy of your **current matriculation card** and a **head & shoulders photograph**. If applying for a full Ticket, please also include a copy of your **valid official handicap certificate**.

HOW TO APPLY – CURRENT STUDENT TICKET HOLDERS

For Students who currently hold a Student Summer Ticket and are looking to renew their term-time ticket, please note the Summer ticket will continue to be valid until close of play on Monday 31 August 2026. The term-time ticket can be renewed from Wednesday 26 August 2026 and we will email you a renewal link to allow you to renew online. Alternatively, please visit Pilmour House and complete an application form in person. Our office is open Monday to Friday, 09:00-16:30. This ticket will be valid for play from 01 September 2026 to 31 May 2027.

HOW TO APPLY - PREVIOUS STUDENT TICKET HOLDERS

For previous term-time Student ticket holders who still have a current matriculation card, you can renew a term-time ticket from Wednesday 26 August 2026. The ticket will be valid for play from 01 September 2026 to 31 May 2027.

Please complete the **application form** and email to yearlytickets@standrews.com including a copy of your **current matriculation card**. If applying for the Full Ticket, please also include a copy of your **valid official handicap certificate**. A renewal invite can then be emailed to you. Alternatively, please visit Pilmour House and complete an application form in person. Our office is open Monday to Friday, 09:00-16:30.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The Student Term-Time Links Ticket is valid for play 01 September 2026 to 31 May 2027.
- Full-time matriculated students at St Andrews University can apply. A valid matriculation card must be shown at the time of purchase for both new applicants and renewals.
- If purchasing a Full category of ticket, a valid official handicap is required (maximum handicap 36).
- The full cost of the ticket is payable regardless of the purchase date.
- The Student Term-Time ticket is only valid whilst a full-time student at the University of St Andrews.
- A Student Term-Time Ticket can only be issued between 01 September until 30 April. No Term-Time tickets can be issued during the month of May.
- Full-time matriculated students at St Andrews University are not permitted to apply for a Resident Category of Yearly Ticket.
- It is permitted to upgrade category of ticket during the ticket period, for example Restricted Ticket to Full Ticket. A change to Full Ticket will require a **valid official handicap certificate** to be shown at the time of purchase.
- A reduction in category of ticket, for example Full Ticket to Restricted Ticket is not permitted during the ticket period. A reduction in category is only permitted at the next renewal period.
- The Links Management Committee would like to remind all Yearly Ticketholders that Local Priority ballot tee times must only be used by ticketholders to play with other ticketholders and/or to introduce bona fide guests and must not be used for commercial/personal financial gain. The tee times give eligible ticketholders a range of start times that only they can apply for which gives preference over other ticketholders and visitors. Old <i>(2 or more golfers)</i>	To enter the Old Course Ballot there must be at least two golfers and entries can be made online via our website, through the Home of Golf App, in person, or by telephone (0)1334 466666 prior to 2.00pm two days before you hope to play the Old Course. The Ballot will take place every day of the week with the exception of Friday, as there is no play on the Old Course on Sundays. Please check the Busy Dates on our website, or through the Home of Golf App, to ensure the Old Course is open on the day you wish to play. All Ballot entries require names, home clubs, handicaps and ticket numbers. 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	Dark Times Dark times are those tee times at the end of the day where it might not be possible to complete your round of golf before darkness falls. There is however still demand to play in these times on the Old Course and it is important to allocate these in a consistent manner. Dark times are allocated as follows: • The ballot entry allows ticket holders who are eligible for the Local Priority Ballot to accept the possibility of being drawn in a dark time by ticking an acceptance box. • Up to the first SEVEN dark times will be allocated to ticket holders who have indicated they wish to play in dark times and who have been unsuccessful in the Local Priority Ballot. • If any of the first SEVEN dark times have not been allocated in the Ballot process, they are distributed on the day of play by the Starters to any ticket holder, in person at the Starter's Box, on a first come first serve basis up until 09:00. The time is allocated at this stage, and details of additional golfers can be finalised at the time of play. • Should the available dark times still not have been allocated to a ticket holder by 09:00 on the day of play, they can be allocated to any golfer through the daily Waiting List as operated by the staff in the Old Pavilion. • Dark times numbers EIGHT onwards (more than one hour into dark times) can still be issued by the Starter to any ticket holder.
Old (single golfer)	The Singles Daily Draw efficiently manages the allocation of any available tee times for single golfers. Single golfers can enter the draw between 09:00 and 17:00 on the day before they wish to play at either The Old Pavilion or Links Clubhouse. Entries are in person only. The draw will take place at 17:00, and the results will be randomised. Any available tee times will then be allocated in chronological order starting at the top of the list. Entrants will be notified via email and SMS message, if phone number provided, whether they have been allocated a tee time for the following day. New	Play is predominantly on a first-come, first-served basis, but golfers should note that R&A members have the right to claim every alternate tee time, except on Sundays and when the Club has times on The Old Course reserved exclusively for its members for two hours a day in August and three hours a day in September. Available tee times are allocated on a ‘walk-up’ basis by approaching the Starter on the day. All ticketholders have exclusive access between 06:32 – 09:28, when daylight permits. Resident, North East Fife and Student ticketholders have priority between 17:00 – 18:00, when daylight permits.

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GOLFING ETIQUETTE

It is important for the future of student golf that the traditional etiquette of the game is observed in St Andrews.

1. Always play without delay, keep up with the match in front, do not practice and move off the green to the next tee before marking scorecards. Tee-off as soon as it is safe to do so.
2. If you cannot find your ball immediately, signal the following players through as soon as they are ready to play and if playing in a three or four ball, allow two ball matches to play through.
3. Do not play if golfers in front are within range.
4. Repair any pitch marks made on the greens immediately to prevent damage.
5. Respect the courses and the course equipment and avoid damage to them.
6. Rake bunkers after use.
7. Please note any abuse of the privileges provided to St Andrews University Student ticketholders will result in the ticket being withdrawn.
8. Four ball medal play is not permitted.
9. Please note any abuse of the privileges provided to St Andrews University Student ticketholders will result in the ticket being withdrawn.

DRESS CODE

Golfers are expected to wear clothing appropriate for golf. Scruffy or torn clothing is not considered appropriate. If in doubt, please consult the Starter. The dress code is smart casual in the clubhouse.

SPEED OF PLAY

An indication of the time four balls are expected to complete a round is published on the score card for each course but golfers are asked to ensure that they play without delay. Golfers' Assistants are on the Links at all times to help golfers and to ensure that they maintain the speed of play. Your co-operation is appreciated.
