

Public summary of VU Local Consultation of Dec. 2, 2024

Flexible shell

Figures per faculty have been received on the number of lecturers on temporary duty and what proportion of them have contracts longer than four years. The differences between faculties are considerable and VU still has some way to go before the 17% target should be achieved in one year.

Labor Inspectorate's Psychosocial Workload Report.

As had been reported in the previous consultations, the unions see reason to reinstate the Work Pressure Working Group in which employer, Works Council and LO work together. The employer shares this view. The LO will be asked who they want to delegate. It is important to keep a finger on the pulse of national developments.

Employment benefits funds 2025 and beyond
