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Join a Summer School programme!

The variety of what is offered by summer schools abroad is huge. Some summer programs focus, for example, on a certain subject in a full-time intensive course. Others are less intensive and also offer a cultural programme. The duration of a summer school varies from a couple of days up to 8 weeks. In many cases it is possible to receive credits for courses you follow during the summer programme if you request [approval from your examination board](#).

Attractive offers

VU Amsterdam works together with partner universities around the world and many of them offer a summer school programme. As a VU student you can often get **interesting discounts at our partner universities**, which makes following a summer school very attractive. In this document, we have presented our 3 exchange summer schools, as well as other summer schools from partner universities which offer either tuition fee waivers to our students or attractive offers. 5 Reasons why you should take part in a Summer School

1. You get international and intercultural experience during a short amount of time, which is usually cheaper than a whole exchange semester
2. You get the chance to study at some of the world's best universities, some of which don't offer a normal exchange semester with VU Amsterdam (yet)
3. You can gain extra credits, which you can get approved for your elective semester
4. You can follow a course of your particular interest that is not offered at VU Amsterdam or that prepares you for a specific Master's
5. You will make your CV stand out from the competition

- To apply for one of these 3 summer schools partners and get your fee waived, you must be nominated by the VU International Office
 - Even when the tuition fee for a summer school is waived, you are still responsible for paying for all your personal costs, like accommodation, travel, visa, food and other personal expenses.
 - Register your stay abroad via My Dashboard (Apps > *Study/internship abroad* > *Register internship/free mover abroad*) after you have been accepted by the summer school.

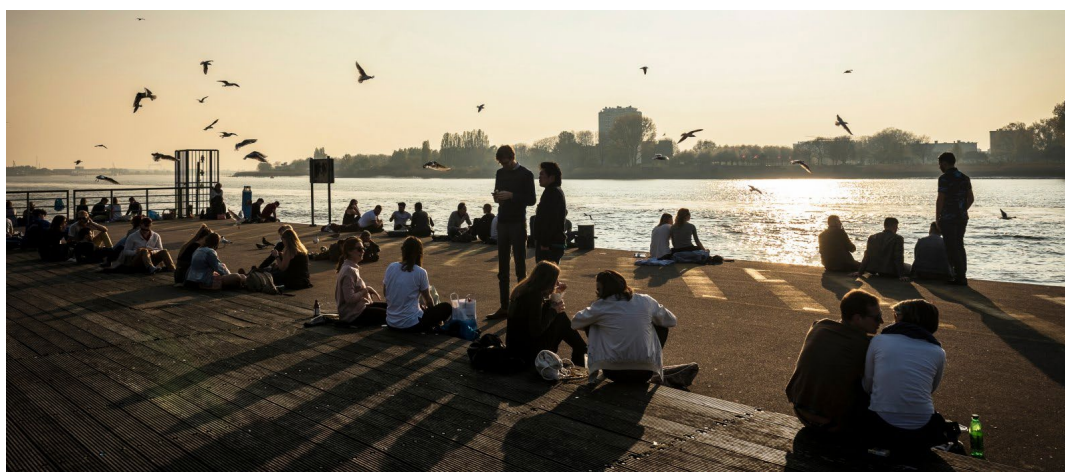

- **Name Programme:** ETH SSRF Summer Research Fellowship 2026

The Computer Science Department at ETH Zurich will once again open its doors in the summer of 2026 to students participating in the Student Summer Research Fellowship programme. This programme is open to undergraduate and graduate students from around the world and provides an opportunity for students to actively participate in research groups for new or existing projects. This allows visiting students to focus on research in an area of their choice, under the guidance of mentors from ETH. It also gives students the opportunity to work and connect with a group of like-minded colleagues from across the globe, while gaining valuable research experience. The fellowship is provided by the Computer Science Department of ETH Zurich and takes place over two months during the summer. Twenty international students are selected each year.

Each participant will receive a scholarship covering travel, accommodation and living expenses for the duration of the programme.

This intensive two-week programme enables students from Aurora universities to develop practical and theoretical competences in Futures Literacy, societal innovation and strategic foresight, preparing them to address complex global challenges and societal transformations. The programme combines Futures Literacy Labs, lectures, workshops and collaborative learning activities led by internationally recognised scholars and practitioners.

Week 1 – Foundations of Futures Studies

Participants explore anticipation processes through Futures Literacy Labs, social and strategic foresight, forecasting methods, and the Great Transitions serious game.

Week 2 – Using the Future

Students engage with applied futures approaches including Transitions and Speculative Design, Anticipatory Systems and Processes, Regenerative Futures and Systems Thinking, delivered by international lecturers and guest speakers.

The “Emerging Futures” Summer School concludes with the International Conference on Futures of Education for Peace on 19 June 2026, gathering UNESCO leaders, researchers and stakeholders working on education, peace and societal futures.
