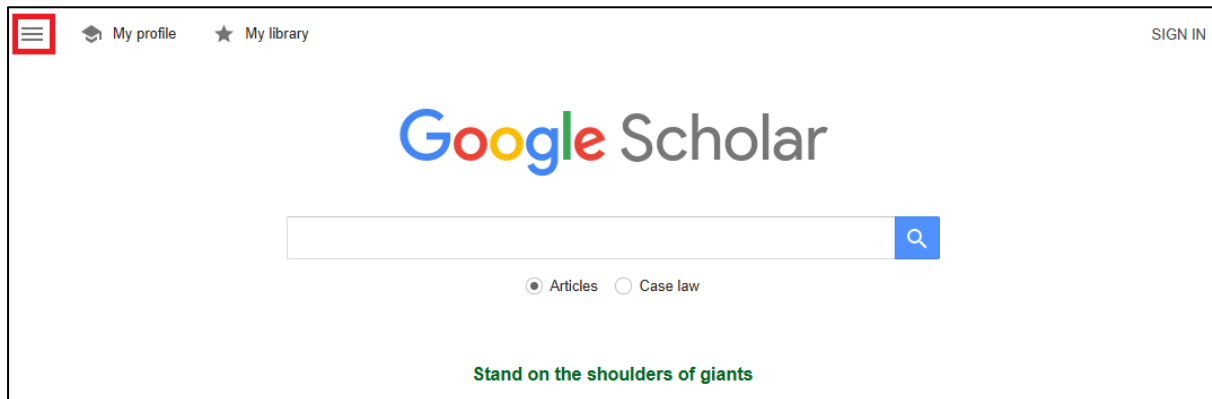


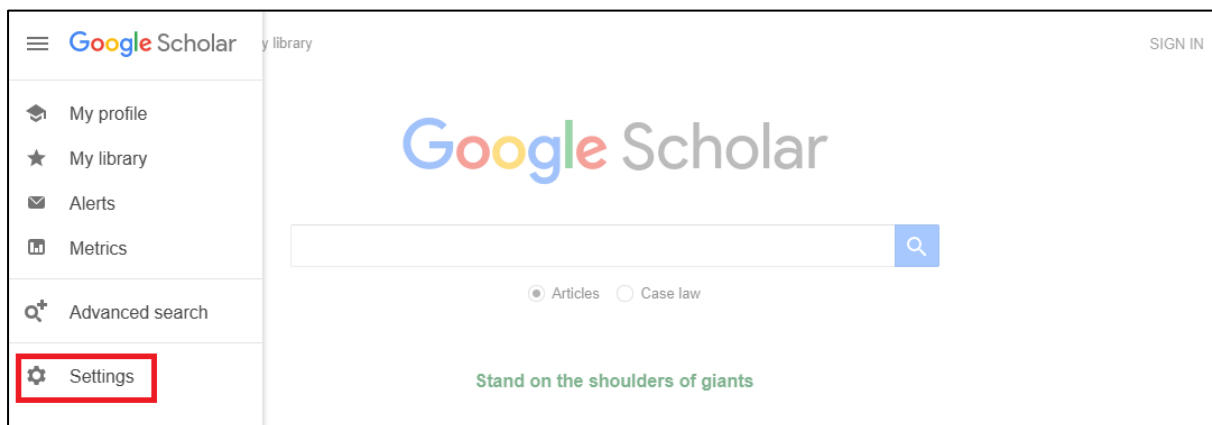
VU LibSearch links in Google Scholar off campus

Install the [Lean Library tool](#) to also automatically display the “VU LibSearch” links with Google Scholar search results when off-campus. Or follow these steps:

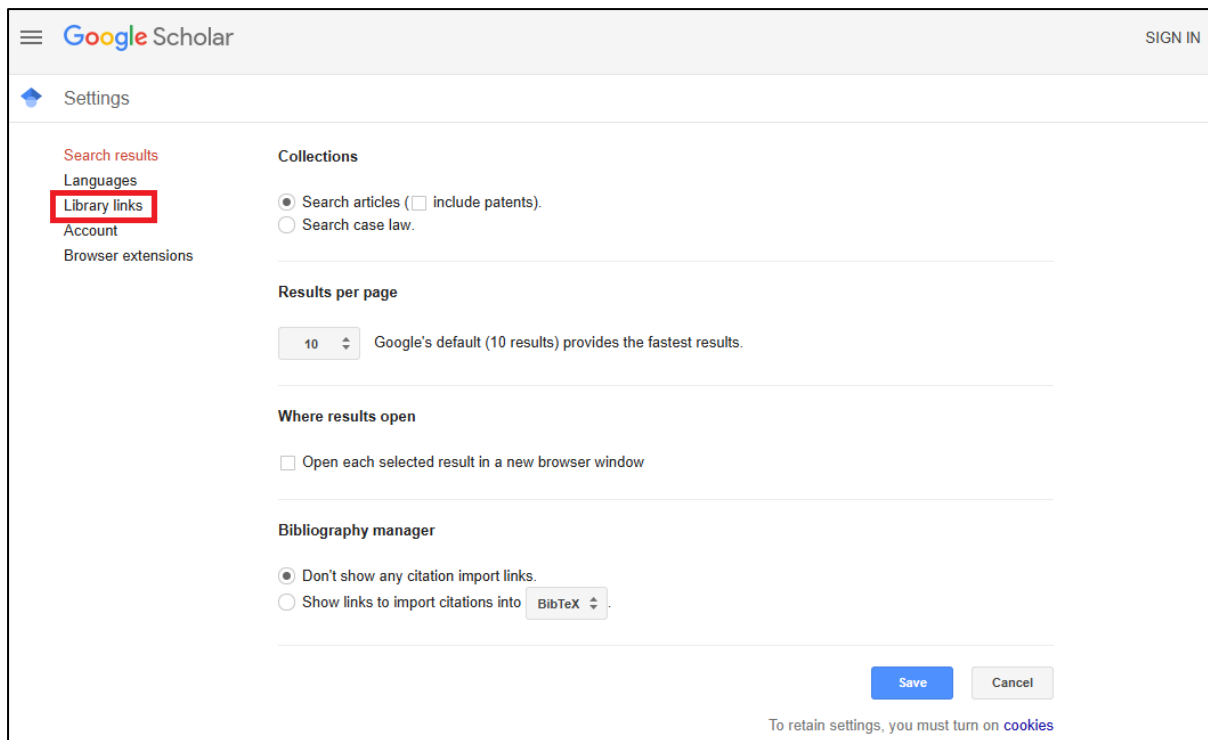
- Go to Google Scholar and choose the menu in the upper left corner



- Then choose “Settings”

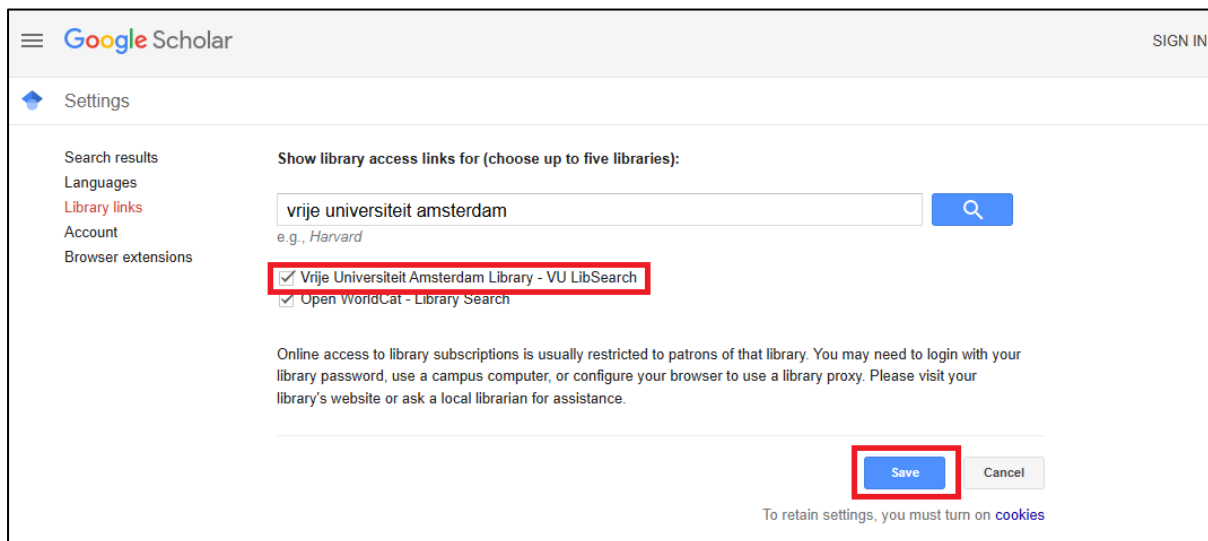


- And select “Library links”
