How does the course work?

Step 1: Choose a Theme Track:

- **Track B:** Health & Happiness, Digital World, Viewpoints & Worldview, Sustainability

Step 2: Explore the Themes online and offline

- **Online:** You will watch videos, read articles, and complete challenges.
- **Offline:** You will participate in discussions, creative assignments, and activities.

- Reflect on your **beliefs** and how they shape your **worldview**.

Who Can Apply?

-  Open to all Bachelor's students (first to third year), Honours students, and Master's students.

When does the course take place?

-  Duration: February to May 2027
(Periods 4 and 5, excluding exam weeks)
-  Format: Blended learning
(course language: English)
 - 10 on-campus sessions on Tuesdays or Wednesdays, 17:30–19:30
 - Online assignments completed at your own pace
-  Workload: $\pm$ 2 hours per week
