



## **You may need to declare untaxed income on your Self Assessment tax return**

We have information which suggests you've been using money service businesses to cash cheques in the tax year 2022 to 2023.

If you've used money service businesses to cash cheques from untaxed income, you must declare this income on your Self Assessment tax return.

To check whether the money from the cashed cheques is taxable, go to GOV.UK and search 'income tax introduction'.

If you've already paid tax on the money from the cashed cheques, or if it's non-taxable, you don't need to do anything.

## **Deadlines for send us your Self Assessment tax return**

You must send us your Self Assessment tax return by 31 January 2024, or 3 months from the date of issue for a late issue tax return.

If you send us an inaccurate Self Assessment tax return, we can charge you penalties.

You must pay any tax you owe by 31 January 2024. We charge penalties on late payments.

For help with filling in your tax return correctly, go to GOV.UK and search 'self assessment', then choose 'how to get help'.

## **Amending a Self Assessment tax return**

If you need to amend a Self Assessment tax return you've already sent us, go to GOV.UK and search 'self assessment'. Then choose 'if you need to change your return'.

We charge penalties on late payments for earlier tax years.
