# Publishing details of deliberate tax defaulters

Your name:	My Company Limited

As part of a recent compliance check, we charged the company a penalty for failure to notify (failing to tell us about certain circumstances that affect the liability to tax).

The law says we can publish details about an individual, a company or other kind of organisation that deliberately get their tax affairs wrong. This letter is to warn you that we are now considering publishing the company's details. We want to make sure we only publish details when it's right to do so.

We need to give you the chance to tell us of any reasons why we should not publish the company's details. The law calls these reasons 'representations'.

Please write to the address at the top of this letter, or email, giving us any representations by **7 July 2021**.

If we do not hear anything by this date, we'll assume that the company does not wish to make any representations.

If we receive representations after that date, we cannot guarantee that we'll be able to consider them.
