Responsibility of the student to go on summer school:

- Apply for NICE
- Apply for Erasmus+ scholarship and top-ups, if applicable
- Organize travel, including visa arrangements, vaccinations, and budgeting for food expenses.
- Fully and actively participate in all (virtual and on-site) aspects of the NICE programme.
- Represent UvA with integrity and professionalism during the full extent of the NICE programme

Responsibility of Bureau of International Student Affairs:

- Inform students of scholarship and after mobility requirements
- Administer Erasmus+ grant (70% before mobility and 30% after)
- Liaise between host university and student before, during and after mobility
- Pre-departures with Pauline Vromans, lecturer of the *Building Bridges* course, Welcome Back Event
- Co-organise the summer school and be present on site during the summer school

<i>Academic Programme</i>	Entrepreneurship, Systems Thinking, Design Thinking, Intercultural Competences

<i>Credits</i>	6 ECTS for <i>Building Bridges</i> OR 3 ECTS for the summer school
<i>Costs</i>	Erasmus+ scholarship
<i>Capacity</i>	30 for <i>Building Bridges</i> , 15 for the summer school in Kraków
<i>UvA staff on site</i>	Guido de Wilde (institutional lead), lecturers from Institute of Interdisciplinary Studies (tba), student coordinator (tba)
<i>How to apply</i>	Course registrations semester II, 4 December
<i>Student target group</i>	All academic backgrounds; Bachelor & Master students 2 nd year up; Exchange students allowed. *This programme is especially suitable for students who are otherwise challenged in their ability to travel or study abroad, such as students with specialized learning needs, disabilities, care responsibilities, financial need, first-generation students, and more.
