Each year, the INCiTE summer school takes place in a different country in Asia. This year, the INCiTE summer school is hosted at Duy Tan University, Danang in Vietnam. 25 spots are available.

Applications open from Monday 26 February – 25 March 23:59 CET.

Programme dates breakdown: 11 – 27 July 2024

- o Thursday 11 July: Students arrive in Vietnam
- o Friday 12 July: Orientation programme
- o Monday 15 July: First day of academic programme
- o Friday 26 July: Closing ceremony concludes, followed by farewell lunch / dinner
- o Saturday 27 July: Students depart

Responsibility of the student

- Apply for INCiTE and deliver required documentation in time
- Organize travel logistics including visa arrangements, vaccinations, and budgeting for food expenses
- Represent UvA with integrity and professionalism during the programme
- Fully and actively participate in all aspects of the INCiTE programme

Responsibility of the Office of International Student Affairs

- Co-organise the summer school
- Be present on site during the summer school
- Inform students of scholarship and after mobility requirements
- Administer grant (one installment before mobility and one after)
- Pre-departures: logistic, cultural, social preparations, Welcome Back Event

Costs	Scholarship of 1800 EUR to be received in two installments: 70% before mobility and 30% after mobility.
Capacity	25 UvA spots, total of 165 students joining

Selection method	Lottery with priority categories for underrepresented student groups
