

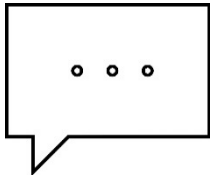
UvA house rules and rules of conduct for events

Below you will find house rules and rules of conduct that apply during events on UvA campuses. The rules are intended to help keep the UvA a safe place for everyone.



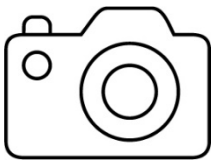
Use of buildings and facilities

The buildings, their spaces, facilities and grounds are only to be used for the purpose for which they are intended: education, research and all related activities. Public events are organised in the rooms intended for that purpose.



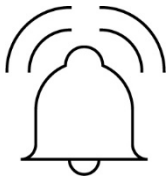
Follow the instructions of staff

During an event, visitors should follow the instructions of UvA employees to ensure that everything runs as smoothly and safely as possible.



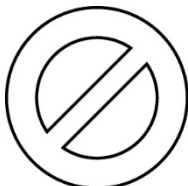
Making and distributing recordings on social media

We have a clear principle regarding photography and the distribution of images: we do not film or photograph each other without permission. We thereby adhere to both our own code of conduct and the law (e.g. the Privacy Act).



Demonstrations are allowed, with certain conditions

We are a diverse community, so please take each other's views and feelings into account. Demonstrations or similar expressions of a cultural, religious or political nature are not permitted. Do not wear full face coverings, as specified by the national government, and do not use sound amplification/megaphones. Always follow instructions from UvA security staff.



Enforcement

In the event of nuisance or violations of the law, the UvA may deny access to work, education or buildings/facilities/sites in accordance with the Collective Labour Agreement for Dutch Universities, the Higher Education and Scientific Research Act (WHW) or applicable legislation. During enforcement, clothing and/or accessories must not hinder identification.
