Universitas 21 (U21) is a unique global network that brings together world-leading universities who share a common belief in the value of collaboration and internationalisation. U21 offers opportunities for staff, students, and researchers at member universities to connect, collaborate and develop their international skills.

Applications open from 5 February – 5 March 23:59 CEST

Responsibility of the student

- Apply for the U21 Summer School Scholarship
- Apply separately to the U21 host institution (including the enrolment for courses and other application requirements)
- Pay for programme costs at host institution
- Organize travel logistics including visa arrangements, vaccinations, and budgeting for food expenses
- Represent UvA with integrity and professionalism during the programme
- Fully and actively participate in all aspects of the summer programme
- Participate in after mobility scholarship requirements (testimonial, promotional activity/activities)
- Arrange credit transfer

Responsibility of the Office of International Student Affairs

- Inform students of scholarship and after mobility requirements
- Administer student scholarships: (one installment of 70% before mobility and one installment of 30% after)

Credits Yes. Pass/fail grade conversion.

Finances Scholarship of €1200/ €1600 to be received in two installments: 70% before mobility and 30%

after mobility.

Capacity 10 spots inside Europe / 10 spots outside Europe.

Selection method Lottery with priority categories for underrepresented student groups. **How to apply** Through the UvA Short-term Learning Opportunities website.

Student target All academic backgrounds. Open to bachelor and master students of all years.
