



Summer school in Asia: INCiTE

Each year, the two week INCITE summer school takes place in a different country in Asia. In 2025, INCITE will take place in Cambodia.

The INCITE summer school hosts students from: University of Amsterdam, University of Edinburgh, University of Sydney, Nanyang Technological University Singapore, Jiangsu Education Services for International Exchange (China), National University of Management (Cambodia) and Duy Tan University (Vietnam).

Applications open from Monday 26 February – 26 March 23:59 CET.

Responsibility of the student

- Apply for INCITE through the UvA website •
- Organise travel logistics including visa arrangements, vaccinations, travel insurance, and budgeting •
- Represent UvA with integrity and professionalism during the programme •
- Fully and actively participate in all aspects of the INCiTE programme •
- Participate in after mobility scholarship requirements (testimonial, promotional activity/activities) •

Responsibility of the Office of International Student Affairs

- Co-organise the summer school •
- Coordinate students on site during the summer school •
- Inform students of scholarship and after mobility requirements •
- Administer grant (one installment before mobility and one after) •
- Pre-departures: logistic, cultural, social preparations, Welcome Back Event •
