

## **BRAZIL**

Everyone is still waiting on the new crop to start flowing; Conilon diffs have softened slightly with just more than 15% harvested. The Arabica harvest pace is 3.5%. The rainfall during April was 40% less than historical for Arabica regions and 65% less for Conilon; however, the soil moisture was good enough, so there were no risks to the crop.

## **COLOMBIA**

The mitaca flow continues to be slow, and availability is limited. Landslides in Antioquia further caused internal logistics issues by damaging roads.

## **PNG**

No significant change WoW. The weather is behaving with rains at night and sunny days. Parchment and cherry continue to come into the mills.

## **ETHIOPIA**

The Ministry of Trade announced that coffee accounted for 69% of total export revenues this year so far. Shipping lines and exporters have struggled to secure space out of port due to a lack of empty containers available.
