

### **GENERAL**

### **FREIGHTS**

- Port congestions, limited space allocation, voyage cancellations lead to increased transit times and freight-rate jumps persist and continue to challenge our teams globally.
- Our strategy is to **persevere** on bookings and **anticipate** shipments as much as possible, studying all alternatives from a "**just in case**" approach rather than a "just in time" one.

# **BRAZIL**

- Space allocation
  - o **Tight** situation for shipments from Brazil to North America.
- Container availability
  - Shortage in Victoria port (still under congestion) may delay shipments. Situation in Santos and Rio De Janeiro are normal except with CMA CGM and Hapag Lloyd.

## **COLOMBIA**

- **Strike** in Colombia is on pause but there is still concern that there will be a recurrence as the protestors haven't reached an agreement with the government.
- Container availability + vessel space:
  - $_{\odot}$  Buenaventura is re-opening at approx. 80% capacity. Only July onwards is available, there is no more space for June.
  - Cartagena has improved in term of congestion but some bookings are still being rolled over.
  - Santa Marta is currently congested because of a spike in port transfer.

#### OTHER LATIN AMERICA

- Container availability + vessel space
  - o Improving for shipments out of Honduras and Peru.

## **UGANDA, RWANDA & KENYA**

- Container availability + vessel space:
  - Uganda: improvements in bookings and empties situation. Trucks are also available
  - o Rwanda: shortage of containers for all shipping lines
  - o Kenya: improvements in container availability, however, there is still low stock.
- Port situation
  - Mombasa operation remains normal.

# TANZANIA

- Container availability + vessel space
  - Improvements in bookings.
  - All shipping lines are available except for CMA CGM and Evergreen which depends on the time of booking.
- Port situation
  - O Dar es Salaam berthing is still delayed 10 to 15 days due to ongoing congestion.

# **ETHIOPIA**

- Container availability + vessel space:
  - Facing shortage in both empties and vessel space. Vessels are fully booked till end of July.

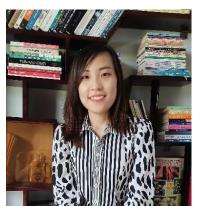
- Space allocation
  - Issues persist over the whole region.
  - Getting bookings for Mediterranean and North America destinations is very complicated and we are facing more and more delays.
- Southern China is still dealing with **port congestions & reduced labor** (impact on ports of Yiantian & Shekou).
  - Though there are signals of improvement, this situation could have a bigger impact than the Suez Canal incident.
  - At the moment, we are not facing major issues, and the quantity of coffee needing to be shipped from China is low.
- Indonesia **overall operation** is completely **frozen** due to lack of imports impacting the availability of empty containers.
  - The spot rate is around USD 12'000.00 for North American destinations, and around USD 7'000.00 for European destinations.
