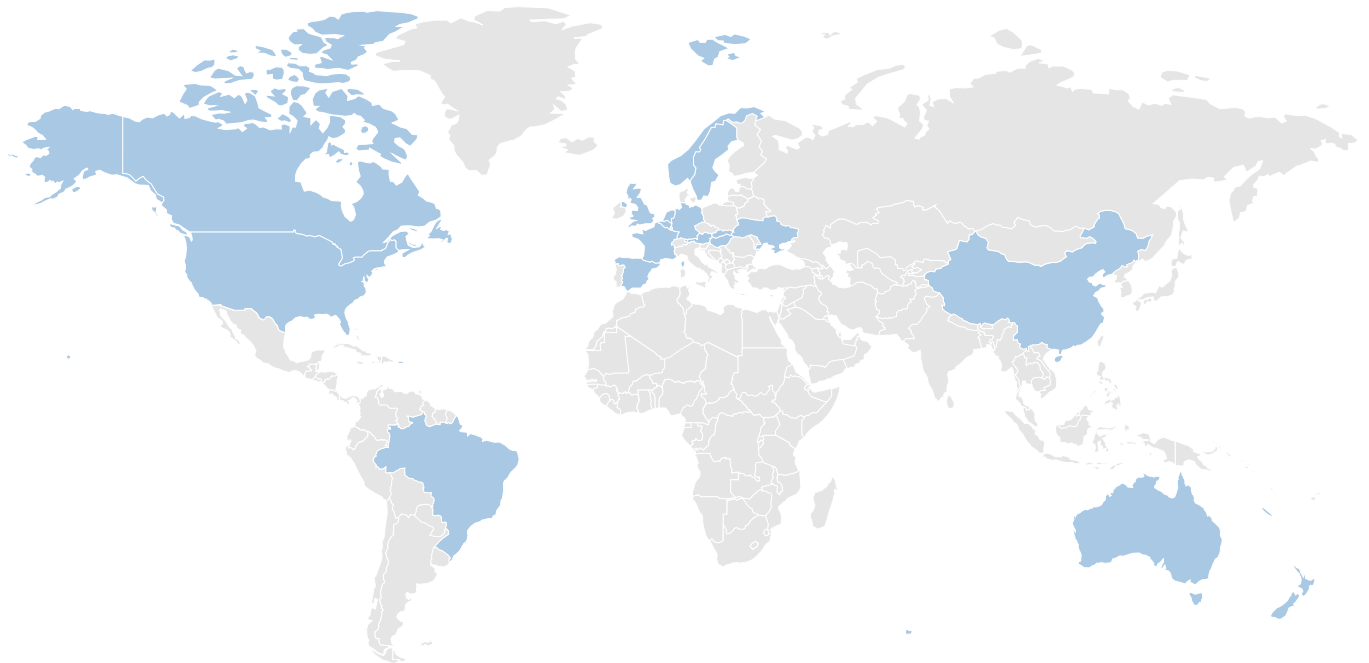


Family Donor Program

Under defined circumstances, DKMS **supports transplant centers in organizing a workup for family donors**. The family member donation can be **organized and carried out in a country where DKMS is located** (Germany, Poland, UK, Chile, India, or South Africa). However, requests for a family donor in the US are handled by the NMDP.

Such circumstances may include:

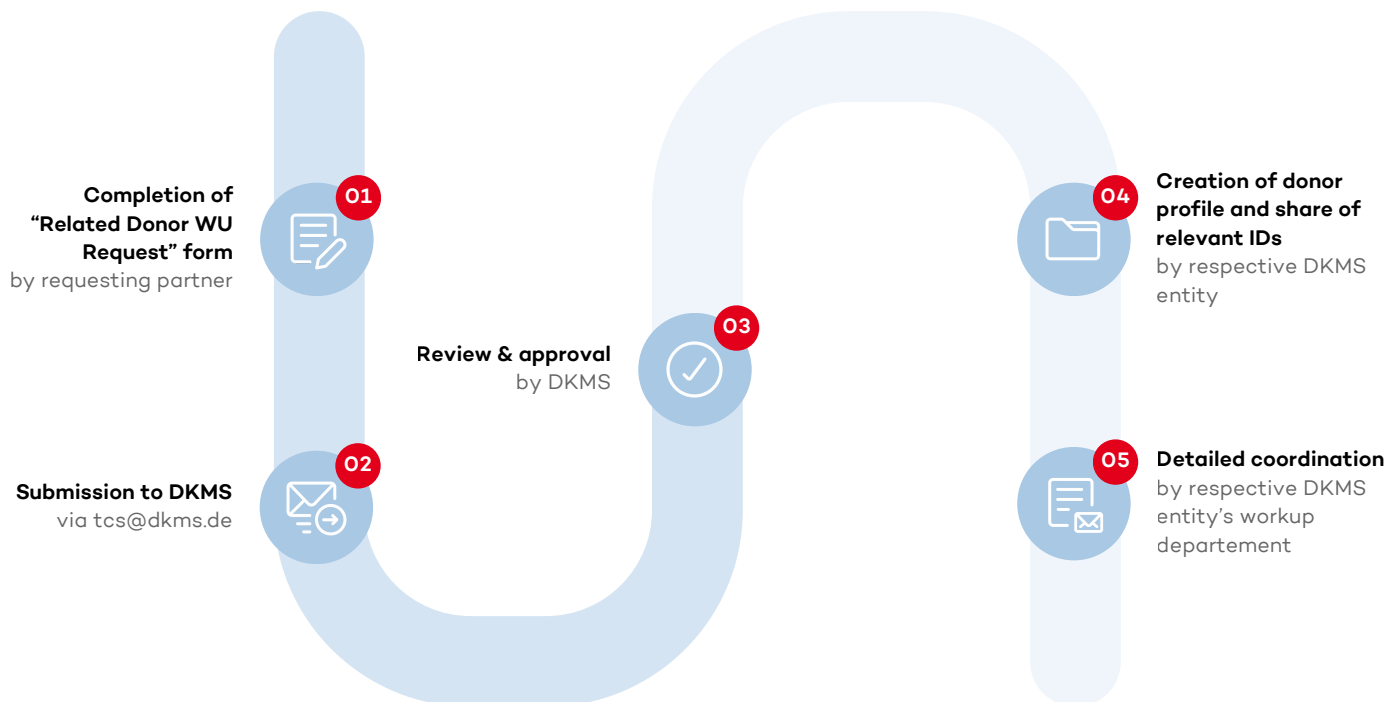
- The family member is unable to travel to a transplant center in the patient's country (e.g., due to visa regulations) but may be permitted to travel to a country where DKMS is located.
- The family member already lives in a country where DKMS is present.

Our support includes:

- Organizing the workup of a family donor living abroad.
- Connecting with an experienced hospital or physician in the country where the family donor lives – or may be able to travel.

How you can request our support

Once you send us your inquiry, we will respond promptly to discuss the possibilities of supporting you and the family donor's collection. Subsequently, we will coordinate everything with you.
