

DKMS John Hansen Research Grant Application period: August – November 2025

## Research scope

Proposals must address issues on hematopoietic stem cell transplantation or cell therapy for hematological diseases. Various aspects can be covered, including but not limited to: diagnostic and therapeutic strategies, transplant immunology, stem cell transplantation complications, donor selection, or cell manufacturing.

## **Description**

The DKMS John Hansen Research Grant provides funding for each awardee up to a maximum of € 240,000, paid out over a 3-year period (maximum € 80,000 annually).

## **Preconditions of researchers**

Doctoral degree (PhD, MD, or equivalent achievements) in a field pertinent to the grant within the last 10 years from the grant call start date.

Applicants from all countries are invited to submit an application.

Selected awardees will be invited to attend the award ceremony during the annual meeting of the EBMT in 2026
